



GHAGBA SHOOTOUT RULES

Games will be conducted to national High School Federation basketball rules with the following exceptions.

1. Games will consist of one twenty minute half.
2. Home team will provide game ball and a volunteer for the score clock and visitors will provide a volunteer for the score book.
3. The clock will run continuously except the last one minute of the game when it will be stopped if the lead is less than 10 points.
4. One 30 second time out per game.
5. One to two minute warm-up between games.
6. Overtime is first team to score.
7. Free throws will always be one shot.
 - a. If a shooting foul, the free throw will be worth 2 or 3 points as applicable.
 - b. If foul occurs and basket is good, the free throw is worth 1 point as usual.
 - c. Bonus will only be after 10 fouls, the free throw is worth 2 points.
8. Players will foul out of a game after 4 fouls.
9. Trash talking, taunting, profanity and disrespect to officails will result in a technical foul.
10. If a player receives 2 technicals, the player will be disqualified from the game.
11. If a player is disqualified from 2 games, they will be removed from the shootout with no refund.
12. If a team receives a technical, an adult representative will be asked to sit on the bench to be the coach for the remainder of the game and following game.
13. If a team receives 3 technicals in one game, they game will end and team will be issued a forfeit.
14. The parents, players, fans, & coaches will conduct themselves with class & exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Any problems in these areas will result in removal from game or event.
