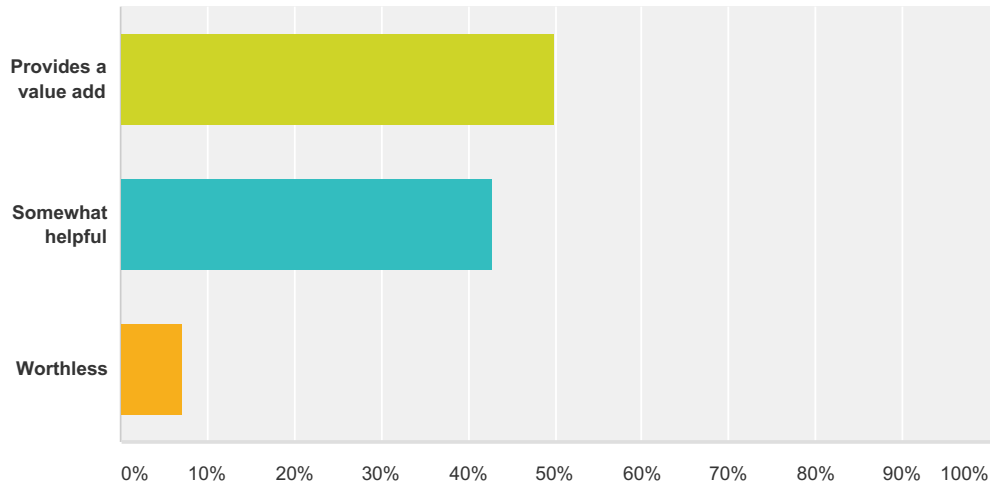


### Q1 How would you rate your District 4 Council?

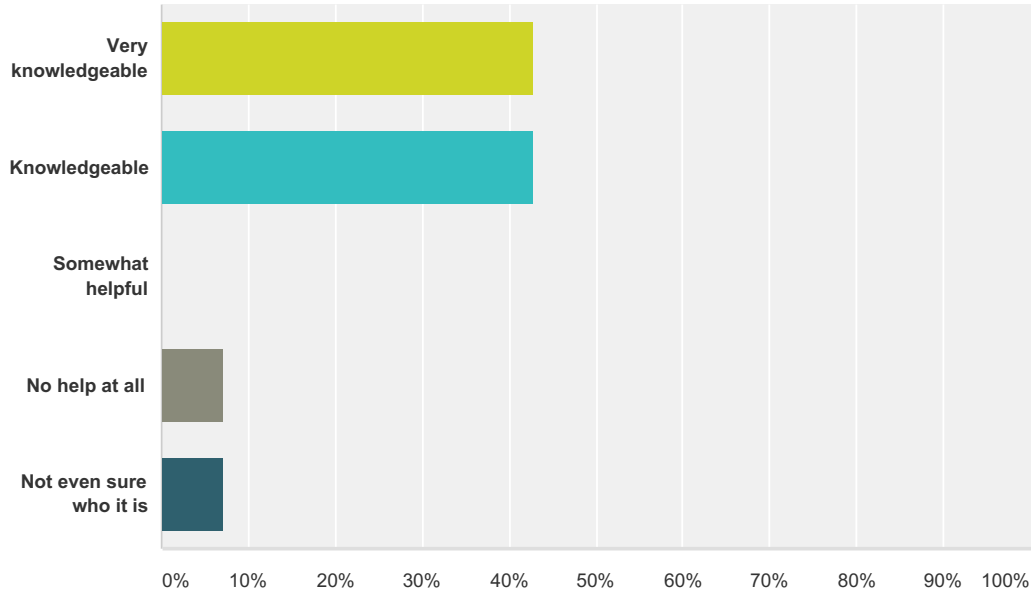

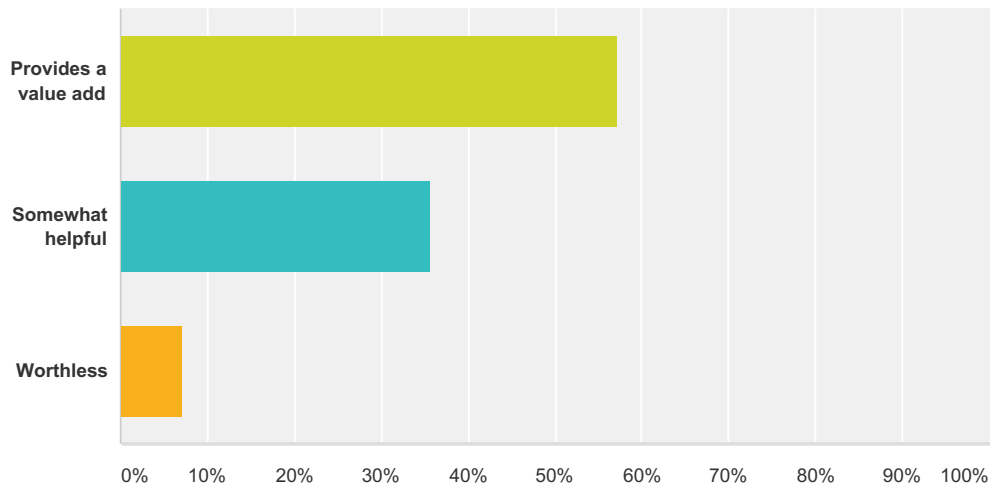

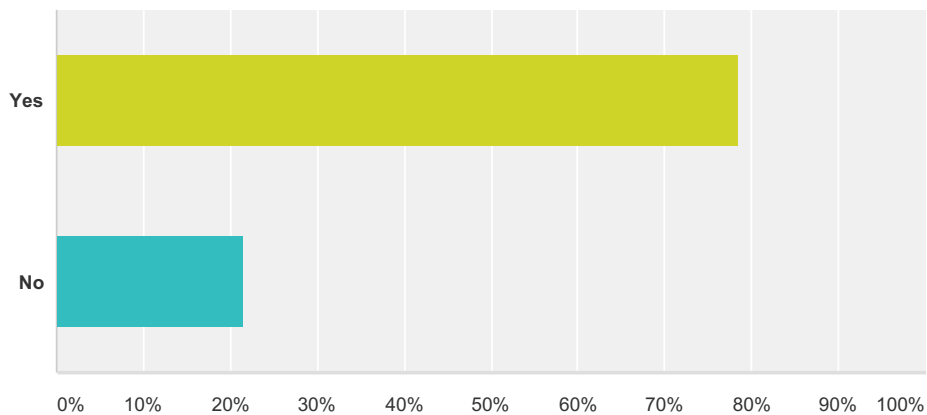
