Parent / Guardian Code of Conduct

- No coaching from the sidelines
- Respect referees, no confrontation allowed
- Encourage all players positively
- Follow communication protocols (schedule time to speak with coaches and staff, not at games or practices)
- Maintain appropriate social media conduct
- Zero tolerance for abuse, threats, or harassment

Enforcement & Accountability

- Violations may result in warning, removal from the game sidelines and practice sessions, or suspension from club events
