2017-2018 NAC, DV1 Team & Junior Olympics Team Entry Form

General Information:

Please submit a separate Team Entry for each Team Event that you enter for the 2017-2018 USA Fencing NAC season (do not list more than one team on this form). Entries are only accepted during active registration periods.

Entry form must be complete with team member names and membership numbers in order to be processed. Any changes to team member names must be received by the posted seeding deadline.

All Paper Entries have a \$20 Administrative Processing Fee. All entries must be received by the posted deadlines no later than 11:59:59 PM Pacific Time. No paper entries will be accepted after the regular fee entry deadline. No entries will be taken at the door.

At the regular Team Entry deadline, the total amount due per Team Entry submitted by the deadline is \$150.00 (paper) or \$130 (online).

During the triple fee period, teams may register online only. The total amount due per Team Entry submitted during this period is \$390.00.

Team members competing ONLY in the Team competition must submit an Individual Entry Form or register online with payment of the \$65 registration fee plus the \$5.00 admin fee by the regular fee deadline.

NAC Senior Team: this is a non-championship event; there is no classification requirement; Team members must meet the birth year criteria. Any three or four athletes who are age-eligible may comprise a Senior team without regard for club representation or affiliation or division membership.

NAC Junior Team: this is a non-championship event; there is no classification requirement; Team members must meet the birth year criteria. Any three or four athletes who are age-eligible may comprise a Junior team without regard for club representation or affiliation or division membership.

NAC Youth 14 Team: this is a non-championship event; there is no classification requirement; Team members must meet the birth year criteria. Any three or four athletes who are age-eligible may comprise a Youth 14 team without regard for club representation or affiliation or division membership.

Championship DV1 Team: this is a club championship event; the classification requirement is A, B or C; the club team members must meet the birth year criteria and have represented the Club during the current season.

Championship JO Junior Team: this is a club championship event; there is no classification requirement but the club team members must meet the birth year criteria and have represented the Club during the current season.

Information Page

WITHDRAWS: Written requests for a Team Withdrawal must be received, by the posted withdraw deadline, by s.ross@usfencing.org. If the withdraw request is submitted by the deadline, a Team Event fee refund of \$60.00 will be processed 4-6 weeks following the tournament. If the team wishes to withdraw from the event with their team fee transferred to a future tournament, the team needs to withdraw by the withdrawal deadline and notify the National Office by the last day of the competition in question.

ARBITRATION: Any controversy or claim arising from or related to my membership or participation, or my minor child's membership or participation, in USA Fencing, including but not limited to any matter arising from or relating to (i) qualification or selection for, or competition in, any fencing event, whether staged under the auspices of USA Fencing, the FIE, the USOC, the IOC or some other fencing administrative body, (ii) qualification or selection for, or activities as, a referee, coach or other official at any such fencing event; or (iii) compliance with any rule, regulation, policy, practice, bylaw, or statutory or common law, of USA Fencing, FIE, USOC or IOC, or of any national, state, provincial or local governing or administrative body, including any issue concerning compliance by USA Fencing or by any officer, director, employee, agent, attorney, referee, official, committee member or volunteer of USA Fencing, shall to the fullest extent permitted by law be settled by arbitration, provided, however, that prior to the commencement of any such arbitration any and all available administrative procedures and remedies of USA Fencing, FIE, USOC, IOC or applicable sports, governmental or administrative body shall have been exhausted.

Any arbitration shall be administered by the American Arbitration Association in accordance with its Commercial Arbitration Rules and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitration shall be governed by the laws of the State of Colorado and the United States, and it shall be conducted in Colorado Springs, Colorado. If the dispute is less than \$50,000 there shall be no discovery other than the exchange of documents. If the dispute is over \$49,999.99, discovery may also include no more than two (2) depositions (of not more than 7 hours each) by each side, unless the parties shall otherwise agree or the arbitrator(s) shall otherwise order for good cause shown. The arbitrator(s) will have no authority to award consequential, punitive or exemplary damages. Except as may be required by law or noted above, neither a party nor an arbitrator may disclose the existence, content, or results of any arbitration hereunder to a non-party without the prior written consent of all parties.

Refunds: For refund of event fee(s), withdrawals must be reported, in writing, to the National Office by the posted date for each tournament. You can email your withdrawal request to: s.ross@usfencing.org. **Registration and administration fees are nonrefundable.** Refunds are processed 4-6 weeks after the tournament.

Confirmation: Entry Receipt Confirmation: IF YOU SUBMIT AN ENTRY VIA MAIL OR FAX, an email receipt will be sent when the entry has been processed through the online system. If you use the online tournament registration system, you will receive an email receipt upon completion of a valid transaction.

Eligibility: Every person competing in a North American Cup/Junior Olympics must be a current competitive USFA member, with an expiration date of July 31, 2018 or later, or a foreign fencer (for NAC tournaments) who can show a 2017-2018 FIE or Federation license. **An athlete can fence in an age category IF:** 1) the athlete's birth year falls in that age bracket **OR** 2) the athlete is on the national point standings in the next younger age bracket.

EXCEPTION TO AGE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (All other qualification criteria remains):

- Youth 12 – A fencer born after 2008 can fence in Y12 IF the fencer is on the National Youth 10 Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- Youth 14 – A fencer born after 2006 can fence in Y14 IF the fencer is on the National Youth 12 Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- Cadet (through JO's) – A fencer born after 2004 can fence in Cadet local and regional competitions, NAC Cadet tournaments and Junior Olympic Cadet Fencing Championship and qualifying tournaments IF the fencer is on the National Youth 14 Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- Junior (through JO's) – A fencer born after 2004 can fence in Junior local and regional competitions, NAC Junior and Junior Olympic Fencing Championships and qualifying tournaments IF the fencer is on the National Cadet Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- Cadet (After JO's) – A fencer born after 2005 can fence in Cadet competition for the 2018 July Challenge IF the fencer is on the National Youth 14 Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- Junior (After JO's) – A fencer born after 2005 can fence in Junior competition for the 2018 July Challenge IF the fencer is on the National Cadet Point Standings at the time of the entry deadline for that tournament.
- RJCCs held between JOs regular entry fee deadline and the Junior Olympic Championship will allow fencers that meet either the Junior Olympic birth year criteria or the July Challenge birth year criteria. Those who meet only the Junior Olympic birth year criteria may only earn new classifications, but will not receive regional points.
- Division I – For national (e.g., NAC) competitions, those born after 2004 must be on the National Junior Point Standings; for the 2018 July Challenge for Division I, those born after 2005 must be on the National Junior Point Standings.
- Division IA, II, III – For all local, regional (including ROC) and national (e.g., NAC) competitions, those born after 2004 must be on the National Junior Point Standings; for the 2018 National Championships and qualifying competitions for Division IA, II, III; those born after 2005 must be on the National Junior Point Standings.
- A fencer who is on the National Junior Rolling Point Standings (NRPS) and is younger than 13 may compete in Senior (Open) competition
