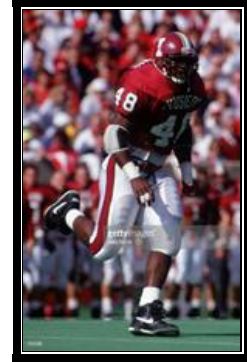




# Alfonzo Thurman



Alfonzo Thurman was born and raised in DeKalb, Illinois about 40 miles Southwest of Chicago. In High School, Alfonzo earned All-State honors in Football and Track, was a member of National Honor Society and Student Council, and graduated in the top 15% of his class with a 3.4 GPA in honors classes. His senior year, Alfonzo had scholarship offers from Princeton, Brown, Duke, Air Force Academy, Illinois, Purdue, Northwestern, and Indiana.

Alfonzo decided to accept a scholarship to play football for the Indiana University Hoosiers. While playing Linebacker at Indiana, Alfonzo led one of the BIG TEN's best defenses in tackles for 3 straight years and ranks as one of the Hoosiers all-time greats with over 280 career tackles. His teams played in the Copper Bowl and the Independence Bowl. His senior year, Alfonzo was selected Team Captain, the team's Most Valuable Player, and was selected to the All-BIG TEN team. He currently ranks #3 for longest interception return in Indiana Football History with a 97 yard interception return against Miami (OH) in 1994. He graduated with a degree in Health Care Administration and Business.

After graduating, Mr. Thurman quickly climbed the ranks in business working for Procter & Gamble, Home Depot, and Safeway. As a Merchandising Executive with The Home Depot and a Strategic Sourcing Director/Category Manager for Safeway, he successfully launched industry leading product lines such as Diablo Creek and Firefly wines, Husky and HDX plumbing tools and industry first sales generating tools such as an electronic plumbing parts finder at point of sale. He led teams responsible to close to \$1B in procurement and merchandising on multiple occasions. Alfonzo received his MBA with a focus on International Business and Marketing from the University of Cincinnati while working at Procter & Gamble.

His corporate experience and success led him to co-found Mule2Go in 2015. Mule2Go's concept is similar to that of Uber, but with a specialized twist to pickup and deliver packages for retailers and provide courier business solutions for businesses of all sizes. Customers utilize the web portal or mobile app to place their orders and Mule2Go dispatches qualified drivers to pickup and complete the deliveries all with real time tracking.

The idea of Mule2Go was born after Alfonzo and his partner took Uber rides in 2013. On the back of a napkin, they brainstormed how to incorporate the crowdsourcing model into the home improvement retail industry over dinner.

Mr. Thurman currently lives in Decatur, GA with his wife Etosha and their two children Trinity and Alfonzo III (Trip).
