RULES

1. Signups will begin at 6:45pm and will close at 7pm. Start time will be at promptly 7:15pm. Early sign ups will be taken at the Anchorage Sports office via email or phone, through Facebook, or side messages to the tournament director.
2. Tournament is open to anyone on a 2017 Anchorage Sports Softball roster, as well as the umpires of Anchorage Sports.
3. Teams are allowed to come with your own partner. In the event that you do not have a partner, there will be a player pool for participants who did not come with someone. The tournament director will be the equalizer if players are odd.
4. Uniforms or numbers are not mandatory, but costumes and extravagant dress is highly encouraged.
5. Throwing order will be determined by loudest player, coin flip, shotgun race, ladies first, etc. Any creative way both teams agree on will choose which team goes first.
6. Game format will be first to the score of 21, must win by 2, the "bust rule" is in effect, and best 2/3 determine winner.
7. Game time will be 5 minutes after your team was called to the board. Any delay that is not approved by the tournament director will result in a forfeit of your match. Such situations include, but are not limited to: Participating in one of the ongoing skill challenges, aiding an abandoned dog in the delivery of her puppies (must be outside of the Cartee Complex), saving a small child from being attacked by a moose, or shielding someone's grandmother from being hit by a foul ball. Any other circumstance will result in a loss for the offending team.
8. All boards and bags used in this tournament have been donated by players in the league, and the American Legion Post 28. Please respect those who have let the association use their boards, and return all bags to the board that they are assigned.
9. **Any unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will result on the offending team being asked to leave.**
10. The protest committee will consist of the Tournament Director. That's it.
11. **Format of tournament is subject to change depending on amount of teams participating.**
12. **Shelled nuts are not allowed in the Cartee complex.**
13. **Glass bottles are not allowed in the Cartee complex.**
14. **Rompers are not allowed in the Cartee Complex.**
