

CIASA Summer 8v8 Invitational Tourney Rules

Summary of Specific Rules and Regulations

Administrative Rules

- All Players must check-in at the event registration desk to be verified in order to participate in our games.
- All verified players must have the event seal/stamp on their wrist (referees will check).
- All players participating in the event games must be present in the official team rosters.
- It is extremely important for all participating players & managers to be responsible for their conduct and behavior at all times.
- All team managers must sign a waiver for their unregistered Players with CIASA before participating in our event games.
- Players arriving late to games must FIRST check-in with event officials at the registration desk before participating in games.

Game Rules

- Each team will have a max of 15 players rostered.
- Each team must have a unique official jersey color for differentiation (i.e. every player in a team must have same color jersey).
- Shin guards are required during all games.
- Games will be played with two teams each consisting of not more than eight (8) players, one of whom shall be the goalkeeper.
- Game kick offs must have a minimum of six (6) players on the field to avoid a forfeit.
- All games are played in 2x 30 minute halves with 5 minute half-time interval/break.
- No offsides.
- Throw-ins if ball goes out of bound.
- No slide-tackling for O40 Division only.
- Substitutions will be on the Fly. However, the referee must acknowledge the subbing.
- All on-the-fly player substitutions MUST be done at the sidelines by the center line at the middle of the field only.
- All players that are being substituted MUST leave the field First before the other substituted player(s) could come in the game (just like normal game subbing protocol).
- A "Penalty Mark" shall be drawn 10 yards from center of touch line within goal mouth.
- Players can score directly from a kick-off spot without the need of a 2nd touch/pass.

- All teams shall be responsible for their team spectators' behaviors & conducts at all times.
- 5 yards distance by every restart

Referees & Game Officials

- 1 Referee per game.
- The Referee has the final say in ALL matters regarding the game.
- Referees will be checking official rostered players and verify having a stamp/seal on their wrist prior & during games.
- Referee's decisions must be respected and adhered to at all times.

Red Card Offenses and Disciplinary Measures

- Any player, coach or team manager ejected from the game by the referee or designated official must leave the playing and facility area immediately this will avoid further conflicts. Referee will stop the match until the player has left the area.
- If a player receives 2 yellow cards then he will receive a red card which will bear a 1 game suspension.
- Any Player/Manager that physically attacks game officials or any CIASA Employees would be subject to immediate expulsion from the event indefinitely and possibly from any future participation in our CIASA league games/events.
- Violent conduct consist of - Abusive or obscene language to officials, spitting, intentional violent play, violent conduct of any kind, use of drugs or alcohol, or other behavior detrimental to the game or players will not be tolerated.
- Referees will also report all game scores and red card and violent conduct incidents to the event officials/marshals in all game report cards.

Miscellaneous

- All children must be monitored & watched by responsible adults to avoid any incidents & injuries to them.
