2. Call to Order at 19h06
3. Approval of Minutes from prior meeting
4. Team Report Highlights
 - a. Boys Lacrosse made the playoffs. Burbank, WA here we come!
 - b. Girls Lacrosse also made playoffs. Game vs. Everett May 9 at Lower Woodlawn. Both Lacrosse reps commented on the Rider Pride initiatives and the success of our sportsmanship.
 - c. Dance team made it to state and placed third in Pasco.
 - d. Golf – Getting ready for Districts in 2 weeks (G), and boys and girls both have state (5 of 6 boys qualified).
 - e. Tennis – season just finished, boys 4-6 and girls 6-4. Metro's today. Will be submitting an invoice for some already purchased gear, and first year with new coach went well.
 - f. Baseball – lost to Garfield 1-0, finished season at 5-11.
5. Erin Paxinos planned to introduce new trainer but late-scheduled soccer game conflicted with tonight's meeting.
6. AD Report – Matt Katinas
 - a. Matt Katinas resigning as AD and moving back to the classroom (Mr. Vance attended meeting to answer questions).
 - b. Vance – AD position is a ½ time role split with a ½ time AD; systemic issue for all schools; multiple Metro AD change this year.
 - i. Going to post as a .8 position, and we may need to self-fund balance.
 - ii. Need to have a teaching certificate to have an AD position in SPSD.

- iii. 2-tiered busing (or other solution) issues. 20-minute teacher contract mandated break pushes start time to 9:00, ending at 3:40.
 - iv. Later start time data is flat. Little to no difference after changing for "better sleep", and there is an increase in absence later in the day due to athletics.
 - v. Parks Joint Use Agreement issues, transportation, etc. "Sleep advocates are short-sighted and didn't consider the whole system impacts of changing start times."
 - vi. Get form for letter to school board to look at the data for high school attendance in the afternoons. Data should be publicly available (Vance) on attendance drift. Late day misses are far too
- c. Conflict between SAT test and spring sport playoffs was an issue and should be avoidable. SAT tests are nationally scheduled in advance, and Metro should be able to anticipate and be proactive, though there are other considerations.
