Player's Code of Conduct Squirt – High School

I, a registered Havre Youth Hockey Association (HYHA) player, acknowledge that in my conduct and character, I also represent my parents/guardians, team, coaches, HYHA, and the Havre community. I will abide by the USA Hockey Code of Conduct and this document. I also acknowledge that membership and play in HYHA is a privilege, not a right.

I understand and agree that I may be suspended for misconduct, while I am at the Ice Rink or during any HYHA activities or team travel, including the following:

1. The theft, misuse, destruction of, or damage to the property of HYHA, other players, or any other person.
2. The use of any obscene or abusive language.
3. Failure to obey any curfew set by my coaches during team travel.
4. The failure to promptly pay, or make and keep arrangements for the payment of restitution assessed by HYHA for theft, misuse, destruction, loss of, or damage to any property.
5. The use or possession of any alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or illegal drug; Possession of any illegal products during participation in any scheduled event at or in the ice arena will not be tolerated, and the product will be confiscated.
6. Littering in the rink or locker room; spitting or other despicable or obnoxious actions.
7. Fighting or intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to any person on or off the ice.
8. The use or possession of a weapon or any item that could be used as a weapon. The weapon will be confiscated and may be released to the parent.
9. The refusal to subscribe to this Code.

I also understand and agree to the following:

1. On-ice violations of the Code will be determined by special committee consisting of the Referee-in-Chief, Coaching-Chief; off-ice violations of the Code will be determined as outlined in the SafeSport Policy.
2. Reports of violations must be submitted in writing, signed and returned to the SafeSport Coordinator. A sealed envelope addressed to the committee may be given to a coach or HYHA Board member, who in which will deliver (sealed) to the SafeSport Coordinator.
3. That suspensions for violation of the Code ordered by the Discipline Committee may include suspensions from practices, from one or more games, from all practices and games for a specific period of time, from travel, and/or from HYHA membership and its activities; and
4. That in the event of my suspension, I may request, in writing, an appeal of such suspension by the Board of Directors of HYHA, or by a Review Committee appointed by the Board. That the decision of the Board, or its Committee, shall follow the USA Hockey Bylaw 10.
5. It is HYHA's intent to provide a safe and healthy environment for all. Any action, which conflicts with this intent, may lead to involvement of law enforcement and/or legal authorities.
