Parent's Code of Conduct

I understand and agree to the following:

1. Read and support the "Player's Code of Conduct and Responsibilities"
2. Provide a copy of each child's certified birth certificate at registration (if required)
3. Fill out, sign and return League Registration and USA Hockey Insurance and Waiver forms for each child to the League Registrar prior to his/her participation
4. Acquire the appropriate equipment
5. Support the coach and assist where possible
6. Encourage and promote good sportsmanship
7. Assist in volunteer hours required to maintain the league (clean up around the rink, putting down ice, etc.)
8. Promptly pay, or make and keep arrangements for the payment of fees, dues and charges for membership, ice time, or travel costs.
9. Parents Agree to abide by USA Hockey rules and set forth by the SafeSport Policy for items of concern

CONDUCT

- (1) Parents will not question the "coach's coaching" during or after practices and games. The same applies for questioning the referees during or after games. Parents belong in the stands, not behind the bench. The practice of parents approaching a coach or referee immediately following a game to voice a complaint is strictly forbidden.
- (2) Positive and encouraging comments are welcome. Negative or detrimental comments directed at coaches, players, referees, or other spectators are not acceptable. Obscene and/or disrespectful gestures will result in more severe penalties.
 - a. If a parent has a problem, arrange a time to discuss the situation with the age group head coach.
 - b. If a grievance is with the age group head coach, consult the Coaching Director.
 - c. If a problem still persists, upon written request, the appropriate persons (on-ice/off-ice) will get involved to resolve the problem.
- (3) If this code is not followed and a problem or altercation occurs involving a parent, any and all disciplinary guidelines set forth in the Safe Sport Policy will be considered.
- (4) It is the intent of HYHA to provide a safe and healthy environment for all. Any action that conflicts with this intent, may lead to involvement of law enforcement and/or legal authorities. Reports of violations must be submitted in writing, signed and returned to the SafeSport Coordinator. A sealed envelope addressed to the committee may be given to a coach or HYHA Board member, who in which will deliver (sealed) to the SafeSport Coordinator.
