



# 2019 Millard United Classic Baseball

## Pitching and Catching Rules:

### 3/4U, 5U and 6U

- Players are not allowed to pitch.
- The player fielding the pitcher's position shall take position always to the rear of the pitching plate, and on the left or right side of the coach-pitcher.

### 7U

- Players are not allowed to pitch.
- The player fielding the pitcher's position shall take position always to the rear of the pitching plate, and on the left or right side of the coach-pitcher.

### 8U (40 Feet), 9U (46 Feet) & 10U (46 Feet)

Pitch Count Limits / Required Days of Rest

Pitches	Required Rest
1 to 20	No Required Rest
21 to 35	1 Day of Rest
36 to 50	2 Days of Rest
51 to 65	3 Days of Rest
66 & Over	4 Days of Rest

- A pitcher may throw a maximum of 50 (8U) pitches and 75 (9/10U) pitches in a day.
- Any pitcher withdrawn from the mound and stays in the game at another position shall not be permitted to pitch again in the same game.
- If a relief pitcher comes in "cold" the umpire shall allow the pitcher to warm up properly with up to six warm-up pitches, these pitches shall not count towards their pitch count limit.

### 11U (50 Feet), 12U (50 Feet) & 13U/14U (54 Feet)

Pitch Count Limits / Required Days of Rest

Pitches	Required Rest
1 to 20	No Required Rest
21 to 35	1 Day of Rest
36 to 50	2 Days of Rest
51 to 65	3 Days of Rest
66 & Over	4 Days of Rest

- A pitcher may throw a maximum of 85 pitches (11U/12U) and 95 pitches (13/14U) in a day.
- Any pitcher withdrawn from the mound and stays in the game at another position shall not be permitted to pitch again in the same game.
- If a relief pitcher comes in "cold" the umpire shall allow the pitcher to warm up properly with up to six warm-up pitches, these pitches shall not count towards their pitch count limit.

### 16U/18U (MABL) (60 Feet, 6 inches)

## Classic League Pitching Limits and Required Rest Periods Summary

Maximum Pitches per day

<b>Age League</b>	<b>Pitches per day</b>
8U	50 pitches per day
9-10U	75 pitches per day
11-12U	85 pitches per day
13-16U	95 pitches per day
17-18U	105 pitches per day

**Exception:** If a pitcher reaches the limit imposed in Regulation VI (c) for his/her league age while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs:

1. That batter reaches base;
2. That batter is put out;
3. The third out is made to complete the half-inning.

**Note 1: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.**

**Note 2: Any player who has played the position of catcher in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.**
