Football

The Titans defeated Conant in overtime, 27-21 at home on Friday, September 8, to move to 3-0 on the young season.

Senior Savontae Garner scored the winning touchdown after the Titans defense held the Cougars scoreless in the first overtime period. Garner was playing in his first game after returning from a hamstring injury.

"It was surreal," Garner told the Glenview Lantern. "I didn't imagine any of that. I didn't expect any of that. I was just destined to get in."

The Titans are off to their best start since 2014 and travel to Barrington on Sept 15.

Girls Golf

The Girls varsity golf team began their Labor Day week with a close loss to Loyola Academy, 175-169 at Glencoe Golf Club. Hanna Tanaka shared medalist honors with Nina R from Loyola, with both shooting a 40. The team then played Niles West at Tam O'Shanter Golf Course and won with a score of 145-199. Leading the way were medalist Maria Perakis, shooting an even par 33, as well as Hanna Tanaka and Sophia Lau, shooting a 35 and 36 respectively. The ladies will continue a busy stretch next week with matches against Evanston, Maine South, Wheeling as well as an invite in Rockford on Saturday.

Boys Golf

The Glenbrook South boys' golf team met two CSL teams this week and came out winners in both competitions.

First, on Tuesday, September 5th, the Titans met Maine South on our home course and won 154 to 157. Scoring low for GBS were junior Jack Upperman with a two over par 37 followed by senior Jack Grier with a three over par 38 and sophomore standout Aaron Chong with a four over par 39. Seniors Jarrett Prchal and Chris Leftakes carded a five over par 40 for the fourth team score.

The second CSL match of the week, on Thursday, September 7th, was against Niles West at Willow Hill. The GBS linksmen were again victorious having their best team effort of the season winning 139 to 172. Scoring for the Titans were senior Brian O'Connor with a one under par 34, junior Jack Upperman with an even par 35, senior Jarrett Prchal with an even par 35 and senior Andrew Waldherr with an even par 35.

The next CSL matches for the Titans will be next week when they face New Trier and Evanston.



Boys Soccer

The Varsity Boys Soccer team improved their overall record to 9-2 over the week.

The Titans defeated Maine West on Wednesday with a final score of 3-0. Lucas Balbinot scored two goals and David Joseph scored one. Goals were assisted by Jeremy Weber, Matthew Ruth, and Jhovanny Guadarrama. Goalkeeper Mike Hatfield earned the shutout.

The Titans continued their streak by defeating Highland Park 1-0. Scoring the game-winning goal for the Titans was Jimmy McMahon off a Gabe Diculescu assist. Earning the shutout was goalkeeper Mateusz Odziomek.

The Titans then traveled to the highly competitive Morton Invitational in Central Illinois but had multiple players missing due to ACT testing. The goals were assisted by Jeremy Weber (2) and Matthew Ruth. Goalkeepers Michael Hatfield and Mateusz Odziomek split halves to earn the shutout.
