The possible cure is a bone marrow transplant. On June 30th, Krissy received an update after a bone marrow biopsy that her levels are low and she is running out of time to wait for a perfect match. Years ago, there was a 9 of 10 match and the City of Hope just contacted the anonymous donor and she said YES to be Krissy's donor. Now the donor will have a health screening to confirm that she is healthy and a good candidate for Krissy. Praying that all goes well, Krissy will begin preparing for the transplant starting the day after Thanksgiving. After the transplant, Krissy will be hospitalized for a minimum of 6-7 weeks, and more special care will be needed when she is back home.

Krissy is strong, willful, independent and a fighter!
