MCYHL Meeting Minutes – 10/9/2017

- SP program can provide players who don't have a town to play for a team to play with
 - They need to stay on that team going forward
- 45 minute clinics (3 age groups)
 - 15 sessions \$250
 - Online Registration
- Checking discussion came up
 - Teams interested in checking are suggested to scrimmage as checking in games will not be allowed
 - Concern is that not all players will 'hold back' against a weaker player (first year or newer less experienced player) and they wanted to be inclusive
 - Checking is separate from 'angling'
 - Looking to have a free 'checking clinic' as part of the program to help teach at younger ages.
 - Randolph didn't register a bantam team since checking isn't approved for the 2017/2018.
