**PARENT/SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT**

Your child is playing soccer for FUN. Below are the rules you must observe. Please read carefully and sign at the bottom of the page to acknowledge you understand what behavior is expected at every match. It is also your responsibility to inform any guests that you invite or bring with you to GBYSL soccer games of this expected code of conduct.

1. Violation of this Code of Conduct will result in league action and possible sanctions against your child's team.
2. **Do not shout insults or negative comments at the referees, coaches, players or other spectators.** The referee has the power to stop the match if a parent or spectator is insulting or behaving in a manor that jeopardizes the safety of the referee, players or coaches. Your child, his/her coach and team will be sanctioned for this type of behavior. This can include, but is not limited to, suspension or expulsion from the league and/or loss of team points.
3. **ONLY** carded officials and registered players are allowed on the team's sideline.
4. Alcoholic beverages and recreational drugs are NOT permitted at any GBYSL soccer match as per city and county codes.
5. No Dogs or other animals are allowed at GBYSL soccer matches.
6. Drones are NOT allowed at GBYSL soccer matches as per US Youth Soccer policy.
