Girls Gymnastics

The Glenbrook South Titan girls' gymnastics team suffered their first lost of the season to New Trier 144.20 to 142.25 prior to holiday break.

Leading the Titans was junior Sarah Healy placing 2nd in vault, 5th on bars, 8th on beam and 2nd floor.

The next competition for South is the varsity invite at Evanston on Saturday, January 6th.



Boys Basketball

Prior to the holidays, the Titan basketball team narrowly lost to New Trier at home Dec 21 by a score of 42-43. Jimmy McMahon and Mac Hubbard led the team with 10 points each in the contest.

"The kids stuck to the game plan and that gave us a shot in the game," coach Phil Ralston told the Glenview Lantern. "We knew that we had to close down the passing lanes for high-low action with their bigs, and I thought we did a fantastic job of covering Ciaran Brayboy and not giving them any kind of passing lanes to be able to get him the ball."

The Titans played in the Wheeling Holiday Tournament starting on December 27, with a 63-58 overtime victory over St. Viator. The Titans lost a close game 78-76 in the second round against Waukegan. The Titans bounced back with a 37-32 win over Fremd and closed the tournament with a 54-47 victory against Geneva in the fifth place game.

"I see a lot of good," Ralston told the Glenview Lantern. "It's not like we're playing a patsy schedule. Every team that we're playing has been a state-ranked team or a high-ranked team in the sectionals. The fact that we're competing speaks volumes about where we're at."

The next home game for the Titans will be Tuesday, January 9th vs Maine South. The team would love to see the Titan Dome full for the game.



Girls Basketball

The varsity girls basketball team finished 3-1 and captured fifth place in the 34th annual Wheaton North Holiday tournament. The Titans began the tournament with a 55-30 win over Glenbard North. Kristin Ralston led all scorers with 19 points, followed by Lizzy Shaw with 8, Libbie Vanderveen with 7, Makayla Stadler and Liz LaPierre with 6, Annie Streb with 4, Halle Smith with 3 and Janet Watson with 2. Shaw and LaPierre hauled down 6 rebounds apiece. Shaw contributed 5 assists, while Stadler and Vanderveen added 3. Stadler and Shaw each had 3 steals for the game. The victory was Steve Weissenstein's 500th career victory as a varsity basketball coach at Glenbrook South.

The Titans dropped a heartbreaker in overtime to West Aurora 50-42 in the quarterfinals. Despite being outshot 23-0 at the free throw line, the Titans led throughout much of the game. Ralston led the Titans with 16 points, Vanderveen scored 11, LaPierre dropped in 8 and Shaw contributed 7. LaPierre registered 12 rebounds and Vanderveen pulled down 8. Stadler, Shaw, and LaPierre all contributed 4 assists, and Vanderveen added 3. LaPierre also had 3 blocks.

The girls responded with an excellent effort the following day, defeating Waubonsie Valley 59-48. Ralston continued to light up the scoreboard, scoring a career-high 27 points. Shaw dropped in 10, Vanderveen contributed 8, Challen Flaws added 6, and Stadler and LaPierre had 4 points apiece. Stadler was all over the floor, collecting 8 rebounds, 7 assists, 2 steals and a charge. Vanderveen was equally impressive with 7 rebounds, 5 assists and 4 steals. Flaws distributed 3 assists and Shaw recorded 3 steals.

The Titans won the fifth place game over Bartlett 44-34. The Titans smothering defense allowed them to take a 23-3 halftime lead. LaPierre led the team with 14, Ralston and Vanderveen scored 8, Stadler added 7, Shaw dropped in 5, and Streb scored a basket. Shaw, playing in her 16th and final game in the Wheaton North Tournament, finished on a great note, collecting 7 rebounds and adding 3 assists. Vanderveen recorded 6 rebounds and 4 assists, Stadler registered 5 rebounds and assists, Ralston pulled down 5 rebounds, and Flaws and Streb finished their first Wheaton North tournament with terrific floor games.

Ralston was named to the ten-player all-tournament team in the 16 team tournament, averaging over 17 points per game. The Titans return to action against Maine South on January 9.

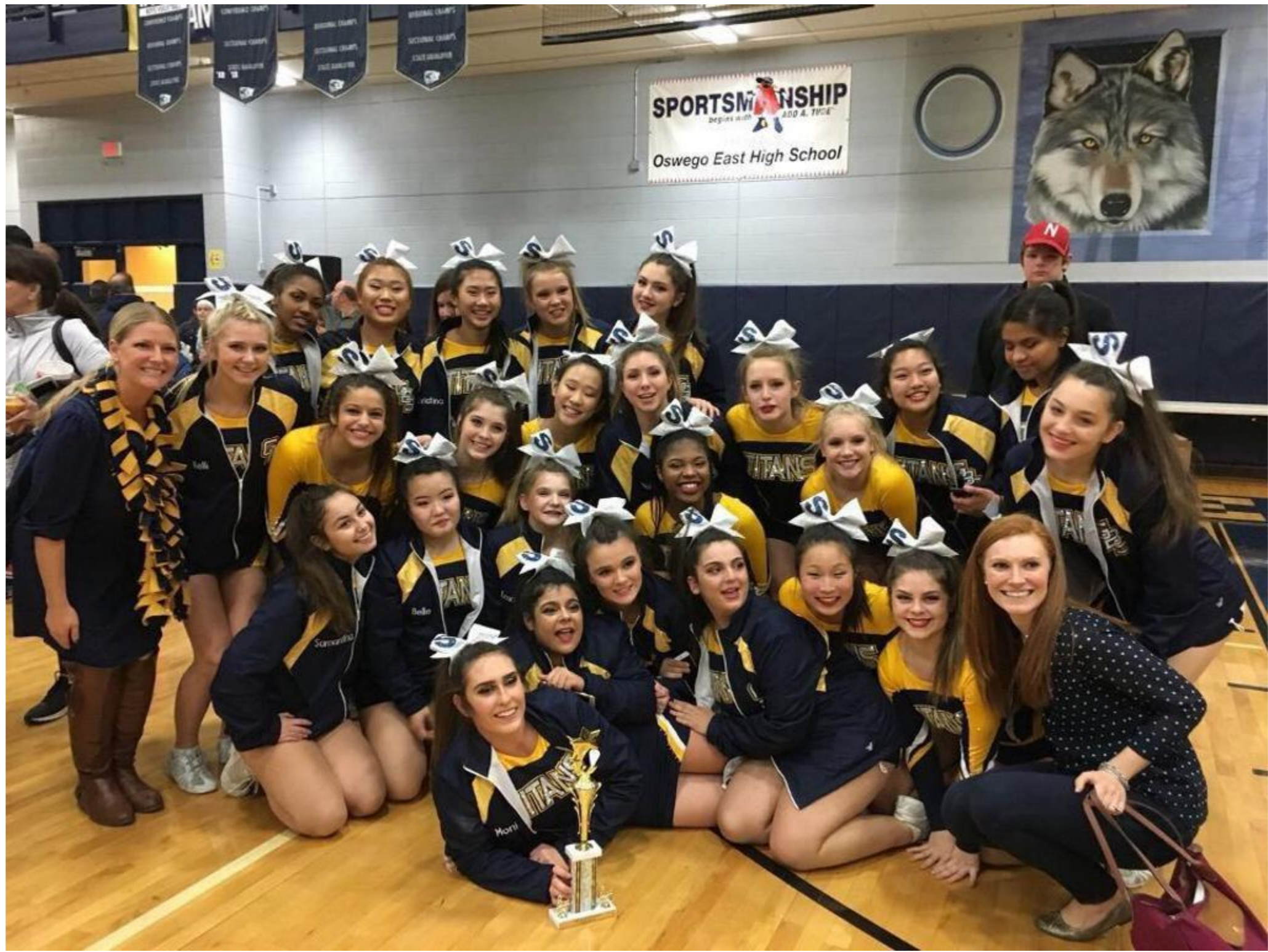

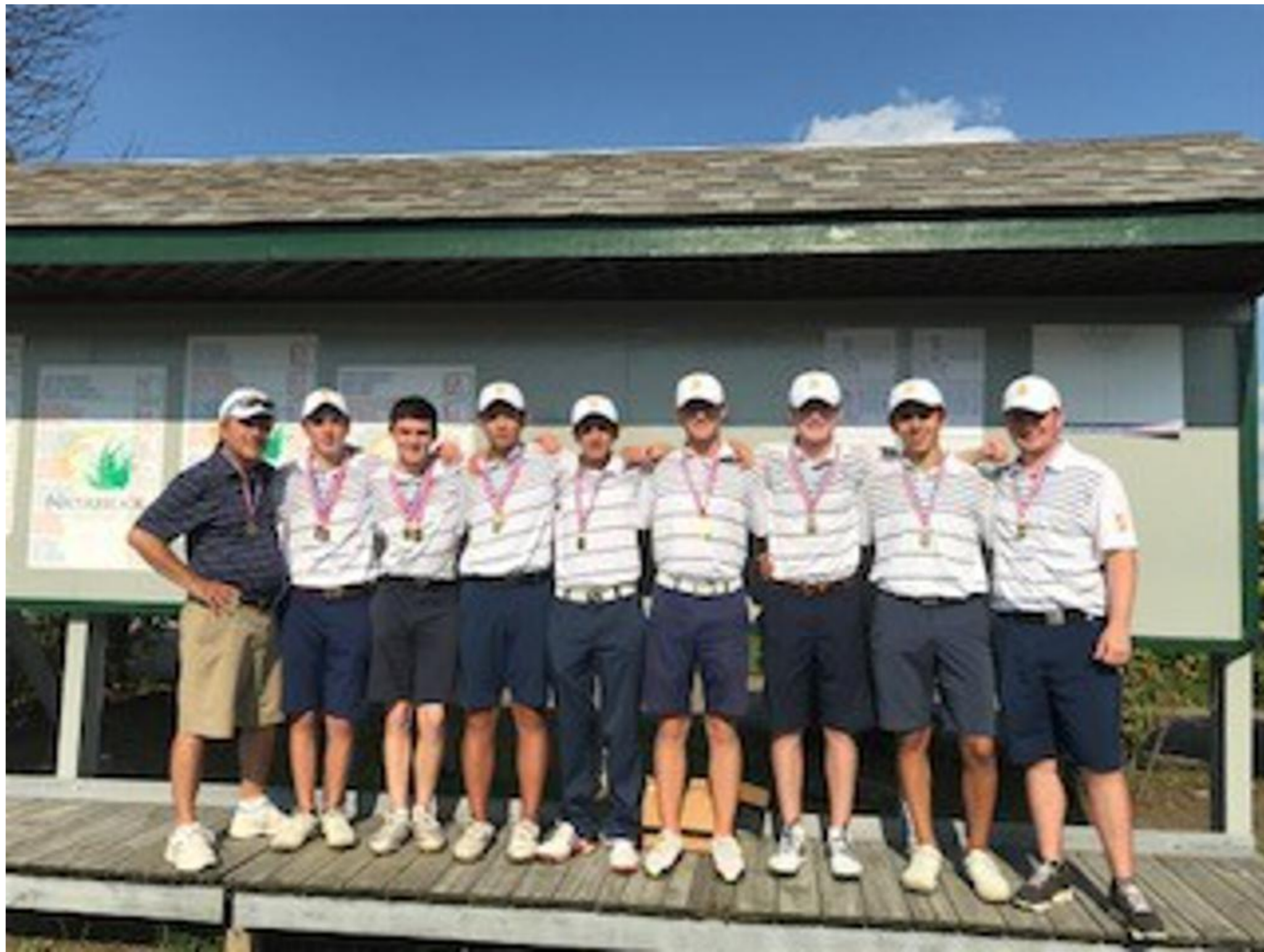
