- 2010 Vancouver Olympic Games
 - Bronze Medal
- 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Games
 - Will compete in 1000m and 1500m
- When she did not qualify for the 2014 Sochi Olympic Team Lana retired but then decided to make a run for the 2018 Team. She returned initially to long track and then switched back to short track in time for the 2017/2018 season.

Brian Hansen – long track speed skating

- 2010 Vancouver Olympic Games
 - Silver Medal
- 2014 Sochi Olympic Games
- 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Games
 - Will compete in 1500m, mass start and likely the team pursuit
 - Following the 2014 Sochi Games, Brian took two years off from elite level speed skating competition to attend school at the Univ. of Colorado and complete his undergraduate degree.
- He returned to the US National Team and competition for the 2016/2017 season.

Sat. 2/24: Men's Mass Start - Brian

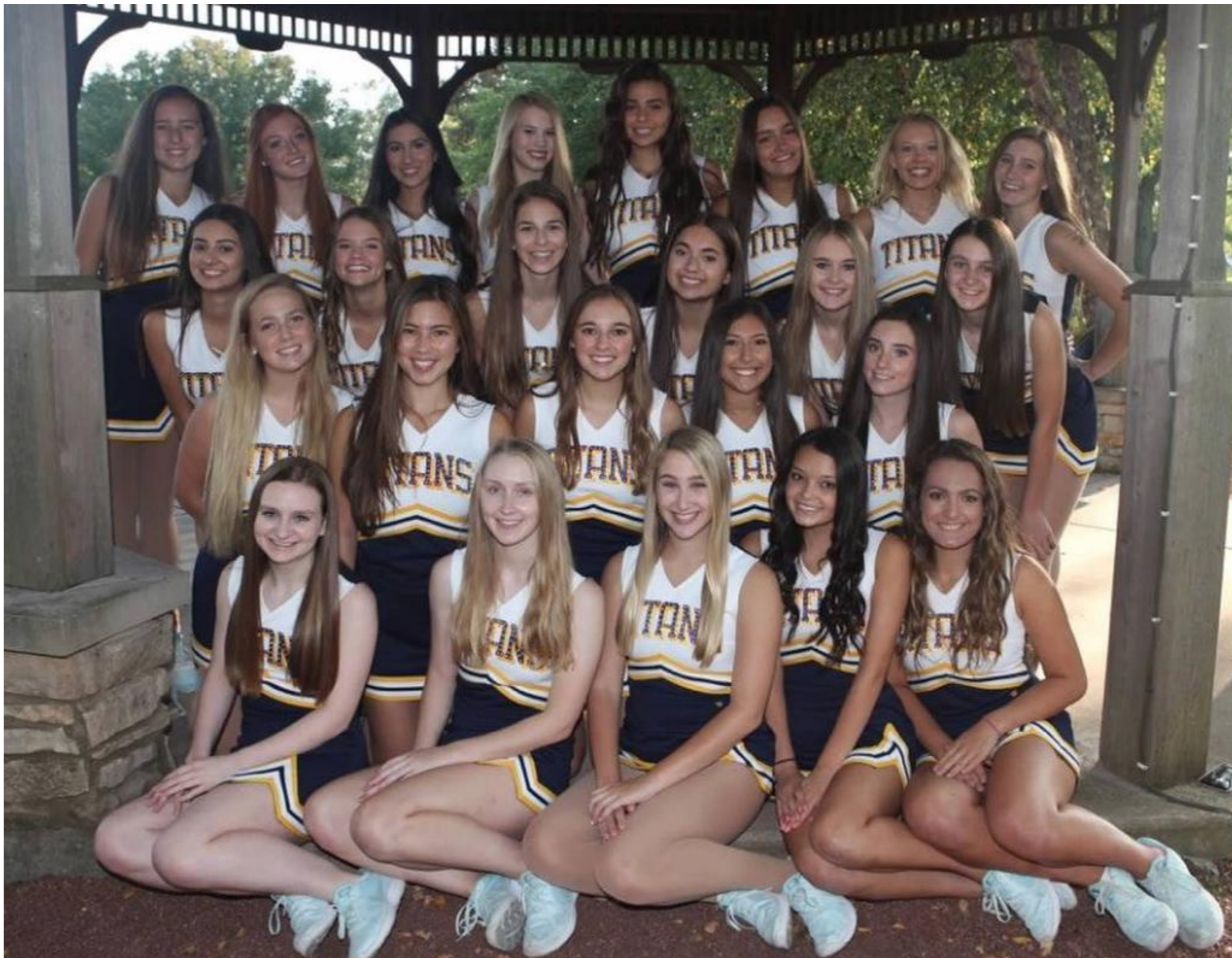

Kristin Ralston led the way with 16 points, Makayla Stadler added 10, Liz LaPierre scored 6, Lizzy Shaw contributed 5, and Libbie Vanderveen and Challen Flaws each contributed a basket. Stadler also had 6 assists and five steals and Ralston had 8 rebounds.

The Titans defeated Niles West on Friday night with a stellar defensive effort. Shaw sank 4 three pointers in the second half to keep the Wolves from taking the lead. LaPierre had a great game inside, contributing 12. Ralston also scored in double figures with 10, and Vanderveen and Flaws each added 4.

The Titans welcomed Schurz Saturday afternoon and the Titans prevailed 66-48. Ralston and LaPierre led the charge with 16 points apiece. Vanderveen scored 8, Shaw added 6, Halle Smith scored 4, Katherine Chu, Molly Sedin, Janet Watson, and Emily Castelli recorded 3-pointers and Flaws and Annie Streb each had a bucket.

Boys Swimming & Diving

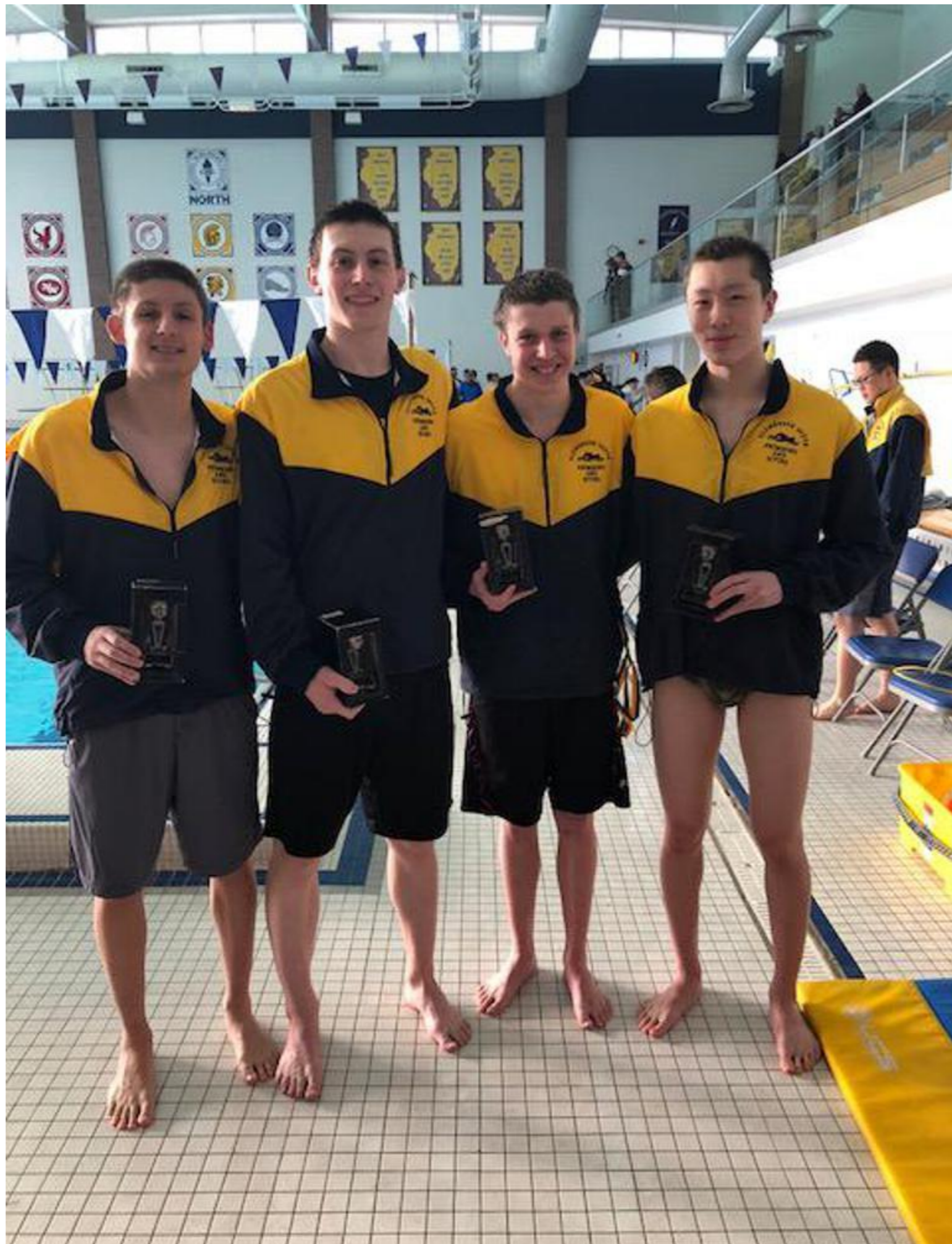
The Boys Swim Team competed in two invites and a dual meet the last two weeks.
