

**SHSAA Provincial Wrestling Championship**  
**March 9 - 10, 2018**  
**Mount Royal Collegiate (2220 Rusholme Road) - Saskatoon**

Welcome to Saskatoon and the 2018 Provincial High School Wrestling Championship. Saskatoon is pleased to act as your host for this tournament. We hope your stay will be enjoyable and you find the championship a valuable, educational experience for your student athletes.

1. Host High School: Mount Royal Collegiate, 2220 Rusholme Road. We remind you and your athletes to respect the school and school property during the tournament.

3. Parking: Please observe all parking restrictions around school and in lots. Buses should drop off students on Friday for weigh-ins along Rusholme Road. After school hours the parking lots should be free.
4. Smoking is NOT permitted anywhere on school property.
5. Medical Personnel will be available to treat injuries. Please make sure you supply tape or tensors for the therapist. Ice will be available for injuries from the designated medical room. Tournament personnel will be able to direct you and your athletes to the nearest "Emergency Treatment Center" should the need arise.
6. Milk will be provided for athletes and coaches at the concession. Show participant ribbon and/or milk tickets to the concession worker. Limit 1 per person for the tournament.
7. Locker rooms will be available to teams. Please do not leave any valuables in the lockers, as we will NOT assume responsibility for lost or stolen items. Please do your part in keeping them clean.
8. Towels will **not** be provided to the teams for showering.
9. Skin Checks will begin at 11:30 am and conclude at 1:00pm. Boys will be in the Boys Gym; Girls in the Drama Room. Skin checks will be conducted by certified medical personnel.  
**\*\*The decision of the on-site medical personnel will be final.\*\***

Wrestlers must be stamped by the attendant before they can proceed to the weigh-in.

10. Weigh-ins will begin at 12:00 noon for those that have passed the skin check and conclude at 1:00pm. So there is no discrepancy between watches, the time will be kept on the main score clock in the gym. There will be two official scales for "check" weigh-in between 11:00 – 11:30am.

Female weigh-ins will occur in the Drama room. Male weigh-ins will occur in the Boys Gym.

**\*\* Coaches will not be allowed in weigh-in area\*\*** with exceptions as noted in the SHSAA Handbook. All competitors are weighed in their wrestling attire with their straps up and bare feet.

11. Draw sheets will be posted in the hallway East of the gyms and parallel to the gyms at about 3:30 pm on Friday. Use the small hall between the 2 gyms to access the main hall where the draw sheets will be posted.
12. Opening ceremonies at 3:50 pm. The ceremony will include opening remarks and the singing of O' Canada. Wrestling will begin immediately after the opening ceremonies.
13. Daily admission for spectators will be charged at SHSAA provincial rates. Please make your team followers aware of this. (Adults - \$7.00 Students Gr. 7-12 - \$5.00)
14. Tournament procedures – to avoid congestion around the mats we are asking athletes and coaches to remain in the stands. Wrestling at the Provincial Championships will use a silent draw. Only **ONE** coach will be permitted in the corner (or area around the mat) at one time. There is a **zero tolerance** for abuse of officials before, during, or after a match. ***Athletes must have a coach in their corner.*** On deck wrestlers must be on the side of the mat away from the stands. There should be no one standing between the stands and the mats. We ask that coaches help ensure this happens.
15. Jury of Appeal – set up to settle “on the spot” disputes will include:
  - Head Referee – TBA

  - SHSAA Rep – Lyle McKellar
16. Coaches Meeting - Mount Royal Cafeteria – Saturday March 10 (approx. 12:00 noon but the time will be finalized by the jury of appeal and draw master). Lunch will be provided for 2 coaches per school.
17. All individual and team awards will be presented upon completion of the final match. Wrestlers are reminded that when receiving medals and team awards, they must do so in their singlets.
18. Sportlogo will be set up in the Atrium area and will have championship souvenir clothing available for purchase.
