4. ENTRY TO SCHOOL:

Enter through **the back door number 10** of East Troy High School. Please have buses and vans park in our **back parking lot** which is located off of West Street. (Look for our School Bus Garage)

5. ADMISSIONS:

All Day Session: \$6.00 (All Seats)
Finals Only: \$5.00

6. FREE ADMISSIONS:

- 1) Members of actual wrestlers
- 2) Two (2) coaches
- 3) One (1) manager
- 4) Six Cheerleaders in uniform. Additional cheerleaders are allowed, but must buy tickets.

7. SPECTATORS:

All WIAA rules apply. Doors open at 9:30 AM for spectators.

8. MATCH:

All rounds will begin at the 106# weight class. All matches will be 6 minutes in length.

9. INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FORMS AND 7% RECORDS

a. Each coach will be responsible to enter his team on-line with track wrestling. Lineups must be submitted by Feb. 7, 2018 at 11:59 PM

b. **You or your AD should have received an e-mail instructing you on entering your lineup. Please type using proper font – not all caps or all lowercase. Double check spelling carefully! Names will be carried through to the State Tournament program.**

c. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

A. *Make a copy of your entries for your files.*

B. *You must name your entries before the start of the seeding meeting.*

C. **You *MUST* take with you to the regional tournament:**

a. *Copies of 7% printouts containing the most recent data on each wrestler that may be entered in the regional.*

b. *Weigh-in sheets from all meets the team participated in during the two weeks prior to Regionals.*

D. *Coaches are required to name their entries by weight class prior to the start of the seeding meeting and not necessarily at weigh-ins. These entries may be withdrawn, but may not be moved to another weight class. Coaches may make changes up until the start of the seeding meeting.*

E. ***There is no minimum number of matches a wrestler must compete in at a given weight class in order to be eligible for that weight class at the Regionals.***

10. WEIGH-INS

a. Weigh-ins will take place in the Wrestling Gym. Weigh-ins begin at 8:30 a.m. and will be conducted by the officials according to NF procedures. Scales will be available when the doors open at 7:00 a.m. ****NOTE** - NF rule change for all weigh-ins: 1. Weigh-ins are closed upon completion of the 285 lb. weight class. Wrestlers not present when their weight class was called may not weigh in. There is no longer a predetermined length for weigh ins, only a predetermined start time. 2. Weigh ins must be conducted from 106 lbs. through 285 lbs. in ascending order.**

11. COACHES MEETING:

The coaches meeting will be held at 9:15 a.m. in Room 603 ****NOTE**** - Coaches are required to name their final entries by weight class prior to the start of the seeding meeting, not necessarily at weigh-ins. Entries will have been entered into the Track Wrestling program in advance of the seeding meeting. Wrestlers should be listed in every weight class in which they might potentially be eligible in the tournament series. These entries may be withdrawn, but may not be replaced or moved to another weight class. A wrestler is eligible to compete at the weight class their actual weight qualifies them for and the next higher weight class.

As per WIAA procedure, it is asked that coaches provide initial bodily fluids clean-up of their wrestlers. The coach doing the cleaning **MUST** use gloves. Appropriate supplies will be provided by East Troy
