

In addition to the costume race, Friday is the day to turn in Nordic gear (race suits, jackets, skis, poles, boots). This is the only gear return opportunity you have. You will have to make special arrangements to turn in any non-returned gear.

Check-in tables will be inside the Nordic Center. If there is damage to any items, please note it on the check-in sheet so we can repair it before next season.

All clothing must be laundered and completely dried.

The 2-piece PWER suits must be returned in a clear plastic bag (gallon size Ziploc is ideal). The size and racesuit # should be written on a piece of paper and inserted in the bag, visible from the outside.

Kick wax must be cleaned from classic skis. Wax remover will be available. Each pair of skis must be bound with ski ties or tape.

Skis not properly prepared for turn-in will not be accepted, and you will have to make other arrangements to turn them in.

Skis and poles should be left in the racks outside the Nordic Center, but must be reported to the check-in table. At the end of the event, skiers are responsible for putting their skis into Coach Drew's truck for transport to Park.

State meet skiers will have a separate gear turn-in.
