Legislative Proposals

- Removal of requirement for host team at Tier I Youth Nationals
- Approval of a Sled Hockey Guidebook for USA Hockey
- Mandatory 30 day suspension for coaches not wearing helmets
- USAH High School Hockey game counts for 10/5 national status with Federation Games
- District Tournaments shall be completed 14 days prior to a national tournament
- Conflict of Interest Policy Update & Zero Tolerance Policy Update
- Junior Hockey – some action taken (USHL our Tier I Junior League)
 - Expansion of Tier I & Tier II Junior for USA Hockey Approval (PD & Business)
 - Licensing Agreements – 5 year agreements
 - Leagues would govern with USAH BOD oversight on playing rules, expansion, roster size – Tier I Operating Standards in Agreement
 - Tier I – player movement, draft, player protection, SafeSport, etc.
