Call to Order

Doug Iracki, President, called the Meeting to Order at 7:03pm and Kevin Roth, in a great act of kindness, acted as Secretary to record the minutes. A quorum of directors was present and the meeting, having been duly convened, was ready to proceed with business.

President's Report

- Mr Iracki presented a review of the WVYSA Meeting that was held during the month of January. The Spring Soccer Season will begin April 14th, 2018. Girls teams will play on Saturday and Mixed/Boys teams will play on Sunday. The WVYSA Board of Directors requested that a vote take place at the affiliate Clubs regarding the purchase of a Post Office Box for WVYSA. KYSA voted unanimously to decline their request. A general discussion at the WVYSA centered around travel players being permitted to play recreational soccer in the league. The discussion will continue throughout the spring. The WVYSA Board of Directors requested that a vote take place at the affiliate Clubs regarding "exemptions" for any other reason besides a medical request. KYSA voted unanimously against the recommendation. EPYSA will increase Fall 2018 prices for teams from \$6 to \$10 and insurance from \$25 to \$32.

Vice President's Report

- Mr Roth recommended that we utilize a professional salesperson to sell business sponsorships for KYSA. He also discussed his thoughts on involving more parents with the operation of the league. Mr Roth also discussed the scheduled for Kingston Rec Futsal Season and expressed his opinion that the season should not start until after January 1st each year.

- Mr Zerra discussed the current balances in the KYSA Banking accounts. Statements will be available by email and will be forwarded to all members of the KYSA Board. Referees will be paid by online bill pay for the 2018 seasons.

These items would be optional for the parents and players to purchase. They also presented a few new fundraising opportunities with Revello's Pizza, Applebee's Breakfast, and Mom & Pop's Pierogis. Ms Yuhas and Mrs Heffron will pick two (2) fundraisers to execute during the Spring Season.
