It is important that parents proactively seek conversations about the Little League experience with their players. Here are some suggestions for how to engage your child in a conversation about sports.

1. **Establish Your Goal—A Conversation Among Equals**
2. **Adopt a Tell-Me-More Attitude**
3. **Use Open-Ended Questions**
4. **Also ask about life-lesson and character issues**
5. **Show You Are Listening**
6. **Let Your Child Set the Terms**
7. **Connect through activity**
