

Agreement For Services

The purpose of this Agreement is to formalize and provide referee assignor services to the affiliated members of Florida Youth Soccer Association (FYSA) by United States Soccer Federation (USSF) certified and registered referee assignors members of Florida State Referees (FSR).

This Agreement is negotiated and agreed to between Full Affiliated and Associate Affiliated members of FYSA, the Affiliate, and individual members of FSR certified and registered by USSF through FSR and approved by FYSA, the Assignor.

This Agreement contains the only non-negotiable general terms and conditions agreed to by both parties. The Addendum attached to and being an integral part of this Agreement describes in detail all services the Affiliate is requesting the Assignor to provide and is subject to negotiation between the parties, as the case may be, as long as it does not contradict, modify, amend or nullify any non-negotiable general term of this Agreement.

What Must the Affiliate Do

The Affiliate identified in the attached Addendum represents that it is an affiliate in good standing of FYSA and that the responsibility of maintaining this affiliation in good standing throughout the term of this Agreement is the sole responsibility of the Affiliate. This Affiliate further represents that it needs the services fully described in the Addendum and the Affiliate agrees to fully comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement. In return for these services the Affiliate agrees to pay for these services and to pay the Assignor the amount(s) stated in the Addendum in the manner described in the Addendum.

What Must the Assignor Do

The individual identified in the attached Addendum represents that he/she is a certified and registered USSF Referee Assignor currently in good standing with FSR and approved by FYSA and that this Agreement to provide the services requested by the Affiliate will not create or place the Assignor in a conflict of interest position either actual or perceived. The Assignor further represents that he/she retains the sole responsibility for maintaining this certification and registration in good standing throughout the term of this Agreement and that he/she is fully qualified and capable of providing the services required by the Affiliate under this Agreement. The Assignor also agrees to maintain a complete and detailed schedule of all services the Assignor has been retained to provide under this Agreement and to make this schedule available to the Affiliate and any administrative authority on request. The Assignor further agrees to provide these services in accordance with all rules, regulations, policies and procedures applicable to the services he/she has agreed to provide and further agrees to fully comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement. As a result the Assignor agrees to accept payment in the form and amount(s) stated in the Addendum to be paid by the Affiliate.

The Term of this Agreement

This Agreement is effective on the date the attached addendum is executed by both parties and will remain in effect until sixty (60) calendar days after the conclusion of the event for which the Affiliate retained the services of the Assignor. This extension of time is necessary to ensure that all duties and responsibilities of both parties have been accomplished to each other's satisfaction. Absence of either party in raising a complaint within the term of this Agreement will be a de facto agreement that the other party has fully complied with all terms and conditions of this Agreement and that payment for services has been fully earned.

Issues and Complaints

The guiding principles, rules, regulations and procedures applicable to and guiding this Agreement are:

- The Laws of the Game
- Rules of Competition
- FYSA Bylaws, Policies, Rules and Regulations in effect on the date this Agreement is executed by both parties
- FSR Assignor Policy and Procedures in effect on the date this Agreement is executed by both parties

USSF Policies and Procedures and Manuals applicable to and affecting the certification and registration of Referee Assignors

Both parties, by executing this Agreement, represent that the above guiding principles and documents are, by extension, incorporated in this Agreement and are a part of its non-negotiable general terms and conditions.

In case a dispute arises, the investigating authority is FYSA. The FYSA Rules and Regulations on initiating a complaint will be the guiding documents. The controlling authority will be the disciplinary authority. For example, the Affiliate will be disciplined by FYSA and the Assignor will be disciplined by FSR. FSR retains the responsibility of disciplining an Assignor when there is evidence of violation of the Referee Assignor Code of Ethics.

In accepting this Agreement by executing the attached Addendum, both parties represent that all negotiations leading to their agreement were undertaken in good faith.

Addendum

It is intended that this Addendum is an integral part of the Agreement For Services to which it is attached and does not have any independent authority or value on its own. The Agreement For Services sets forth all terms and conditions that this Addendum is subject to which terms and conditions can not be changed or modified. If this Addendum is presented by itself, then both parties expressly agree that it is considered to be attached to the Agreement For Services and that it will be reviewed as such.

It is the purpose of this Addendum to offer the opportunity and flexibility to both parties to discuss, negotiate, agree and document all services needed by the Affiliate and to be provided by the Assignor.

The following topics are offered only as a guide to assist the parties and may be modified to the extent the parties wish to represent their intent.

- Description of the Event
- Beginning and Ending Date of the Event
- Detail of What Does the Affiliate Require
- What Are the Responsibilities of the Assignor
- What Are the Responsibilities of the Affiliate
- Scheduling, Changes etc
- What is Expected from the Referees the Assignor Will Retain
- What is the Referee Payment Structure and Any and All Other Benefits
- Assignor Compensation

The individuals who executed this Agreement For Services and its attached Addendum represent that they have the legal authority to execute this Agreement and that all terms and conditions have been discussed, negotiated, agreed and accepted in good faith.
