Rules of Registration for Fall Soccer

1. Forms must be completed with all player information and all required electronic signatures.
2. The registration form must be completed by one of the players parents, or a legal guardian. A relative, friend, or neighbor may not complete the registration in place of the parent.
3. With the exception of our Little Kickers Program, **per SAY rules, players cannot be placed on a specific team for any reason**, other than team integrity, being the son or daughter of the head coach or 1st assistant coach, or if the player has a sibling already on a team at the same level.
4. Players who register late will only maintain team integrity if their registration is received before the player draw which occurs in early June.
5. The primary registration period for soccer is from April 1st though May 31st. Players who sign up after this period are not guaranteed a spot on a team. After May 31st, players are placed on a team on a first come, first served basis if spots are available or, if not, may be placed on a waiting list in the event of players dropping.
6. Players may not be registered for more than one SAY organization, within the same league, for the same season.
7. The registration fees are \$35 for the Little Kickers program, \$60 for the regular SAY program, and the Minors/Seniors program. There is a maximum family soccer fee of \$140.
8. Oak Hills Youth Athletics Soccer will not accept a completed registration form without proper payment.

9. There are no refunds available after registration except for (1) A player is unable to play due to injury or illness. A physicians note may be required. (2) A player becomes a member of an Oak Hills High School sports team. The reason behind this policy is that once registration is over OHYA Soccer has to make purchase decisions for balls, uniforms, equipment etc. These items cost a lot of money and we need to control those costs to keep our fees as low as possible.
10. Coaches will be selected by the OHYA Soccer committee before team draws whenever possible.
