#### 7. Basketball

Gym availability dates and tournament team count was given to Steve. The tournament schedules will be set Sunday night, February 11. Seeding for the 4<sup>th</sup> grade tournament will be a draw of the hat.

All teams will be charged \$150 for the tournaments. Please send your tournament fees to Mike Milligan as soon as possible.

Steve will make sure that each gym has an official scorebook, medals and trophies.

#### **Reminders about the upcoming tournaments:**

Gym coordinators make sure to be at your gyms early, especially if there is a Tulsa team playing first. Teams should not warm up on the court unless both teams are there, if it is ten minutes before game time and always with gym coordinator approval.

The only changes from the league rules are:

There is no participation rule for the sixth grade during the tournament.

Game time is forfeit time. There is no ten minute grace period as there is during the season.

Remember that every player in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade tournament will get a medal when they leave the gym after their last game. The brackets will be on the website.

The participation rule will be in effect for the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament. Please bring the official scorebooks to the March meeting.

Only players and coaches (three maximum) will be allowed on the bench.

Coaches need to remind your team members that good sportsmanship should also apply to their behavior in the stands.

Free throw distances: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders should shoot from a line 6 feet up from regulation free throw line and 5<sup>th</sup> graders shoot from a line 4 feet up from the regulation free throw line.

**8. Track**

The CGSAA track meet will be held on April 14 and will cost \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student.

There will be a track meeting at 6:30 on Wednesday, March 7, after our short regular meeting. Please have your track coordinators attend this meeting. Matt and Missy will go over events, practice times and rules.
