I began my volunteer work with youth hockey in the as one of the 9 founding members/parents of the Park City Ice Miners (Summit and Wasatch County Amateur Hockey Association; SWAHA) in 2006/2007. I was a member of the first Board of Directors and re-elected a couple of times by the members of the organization and elected as the Secretary of the organization during hterm.

During the organization of SWAHA, I drafted the original By-Laws, Articles of Incorporation and the Policies and Procedures. As Secretary, I took minutes of the monthly meetings. I also acted as the Utah Recreational League (URL) Scheduler and Registrar for the entire SWAHA organization. I was also the Team Manager for the Peewee and Bantam Teams.

Volunteered to be the URL Championship Tournament Director in 2011. Developed the tournament schedule and acted as the Tournament Director.

I became the Game Scheduler for the Utah Lady Grizzlies (U19) for the 2010-2011 season the year after my daughter was selected to be on the team.

I was elected to be one of the first Board of Directors (ULG had never been a formal organization prior to this time), then became the Manager for the Utah Lady Grizzlies (U19, Tier II) for the 2011 through 2015 seasons and was re-elected for the 2015 through 2017 season. Developed By-Laws, Articles of Incorporation and the Policies and Procedures. Under the By-Laws, the Manager acts as the "CEO" and is the Scheduler, Registrar, Business Manager, Tournament Scheduler and the Tournament Director for in-state tournaments. Had to resign as a member of the Board of Directors due to conflict of interest policies adopted in the new Bylaws of the Utah Amateur Hockey Association, but have been retained by the Utah Lady Grizzlies BOD to schedule ice, games and tournaments, and do the accounting.

In the spring of 2011, I was nominated and elected to serve until summer of 2013 on the Utah State Amateur Hockey (UAHA) Board of Directors as a representative of the Youth Council. I worked at several District Camps. In 2012, I helped to organize the first ever All Girls State Evaluation Camp. I assisted as much as possible with the Girls Camp.

In the spring of 2014, I was nominated and elected to serve on the UAHA Board of Directors as the Girls/Women Representative, and was re-elected in 2016. Have proposed and had approved several funding opportunities for girls hockey. Have also served on the Bylaws amendment committees, served on the Tier Committee during the 2014-2015 and the 2015-2016 seasons, and helped extensively develop the new Policies and Procedures of UAHA.
