### T-Ball League Rules / Guidelines

- Batting team will rotate through its entire batting order.
- Batter can choose to hit from a coach pitch instead of using the tee, (as long as it is not delaying the game). Coach should give 3 good pitches then the tee should be pulled into use.
- After each batter gets a hit, runner will advance one base. There will be no outs and no strikes. Coaches may choose for the last half of the season to play outs. When the batting team players are out they will go to their bench and their team will continue to bat the full rotation.
- The players should be rotated around the infield so that they all get an equal chance to make plays. All players will take the field, no one sits out.
- Coach catcher or player catcher as long as player catcher doesn't slow down the game. Obviously, not all players will be able to be catchers. If there is a player catcher then there should be a coach backing him/her up when coach pitch is started.
- Batting team players will finish running all the bases before the fielding team runs in.
- Help out the other team if they need it. Ask parents to help out if needed. Since this is a "learning" league, the more parents that can help, the better, as long as the parents follow the coach's guidelines.
- Proper dugout etiquette; eating is not allowed and the players should behave in the dugout.
- The dugout must be picked up and the field needs to be raked when your game is completed.
- Weather cancellations; everyone shows up to the park and whether to play or not will be decided at that time by the coaches. There will be no make-up games due to weather cancellations.
- And above all, HAVE FUN!
