

How to Register

After deciding which program/season you'd like to register for, go to www.SFVSC.org to get enrolled! We require a 50% non-refundable deposit of the tuition price at the time of registration. Some teams may also require a tryout. Teams are limited to San Francisco residents, with few exceptions.

Age Groups U9 – U14: Supports players looking to step up from Recreational play with games in local leagues. Second practice is held on a club-purchased field permit. **This team is a year-round commitment.**

Tournaments

There are many tournaments available for Vikings to take enter throughout the year. Teams usually decide amongst themselves whether they want to participate in a tournament. Some tournaments require an overnight hotel. The registration will generally cost each player around \$40 for the event.

Uniforms

Players are required to wear a red and white jersey, red and white socks, and black team shorts. The uniform cost is not included in tuition and is approximately \$103 total (incl. sales tax).
