ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND COVENANT

NOT TO SUE

1. By accepting this agreement and having your child participate in Idaho State University's Football Camp (Football Camp), you acknowledge that there is a risk of property damage or loss, as well as a risk of bodily injury, including but not limited to concussion; serious back and spinal injuries; complete or partial paralysis; brain damage; injury to bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, tendons; injury to or impairment of general health and well-being; and even death.

2. Your agreement indicates that you understand that your child should not participate in Football Camp if:

- Your child is currently under the care of a physician for an injury or illness that would prevent safe participation;
- Your child is currently being treated for or recovering from an orthopedic injury that would prevent safe participation;
- Your child has a history of fainting or other problems due strenuous exercise; or
- Your child is not in good health or has some other reason he or she should not participate in strenuous physical exercise.

3. CONSENT:

By indicating your acceptance of this agreement, you hereby give permission for Football Camp employees, representatives, volunteers and agents (Football Camp Staff) to obtain emergency medical treatment for your child in the event of accident or illness while at Football Camp. This includes transportation to and exchange of medical information with a medical facility.

By indicating your acceptance of this agreement, you hereby give consent to have your child be photographed or videotaped during Football Camp activities, and you agree that the images so obtained may be used for educational and public relations purposes by Idaho State University.

4. INSURANCE:

By indicating your acceptance to this agreement, you hereby acknowledge that Idaho State University will not provide any type of insurance coverage for you or your minor child. You agree that you are be responsible for all costs associated with any injury, illness, damage, expense, claim, or loss that occurs as a result of your child's participation in Football Camp. You also certify that you have health insurance which provides adequate coverage for injuries or illness your child may sustain, as well as automobile insurance for travel to and from Football Camp.

5. RELEASE:

To the fullest extent permitted by law, and in consideration for your child being allowed to participate in Football Camp, you, on behalf of yourself, your minor child, heirs, representatives, executors, administrators, and assigns (the Releasing Parties) hereby agree to hold harmless, release, and covenant not to sue the State of Idaho, its State Board of Education, Idaho State University, and their respective officers, employees, volunteers, and agents (Released Parties) for any negligently caused injuries or losses arising from or related to Football Camp. You further agree to defend and indemnify the Released Parties and each of them from any claims, demands, actions, damages, costs, fees, or expenses arising out of losses suffered by or caused by your minor child that are brought now or in the future by the Releasing Parties or any of them, or by a third party.

6. EQUIPMENT AND HELMET WARNING AND CARE:

ALL protective equipment designated for competition, including mouthpieces, tail pads, hip pads, helmets, etc. must be brought to Football Camp. Anyone not properly dressed will be excused until proper equipment is obtained. Equipment problems must be reported immediately to the Football Camp Staff.

WARNING: NO HELMET CAN PREVENT ALL HEAD OR NECK INJURIES RECEIVED WHILE PARTICIPATING IN FOOTBALL CAMP.

Helmets must not be used to butt, ram, or spear an opposing player. This is in violation of the Football Camp rules and such use can result in severe head, brain, or neck injury, paralysis, or death. There is a risk that these injuries may also occur as a result of accidental contact without intent to butt, ram or spear.

A HELMET IS NOT A WEAPON; IT IS FOR PROTECTION.

Each time a helmet is used, the following 5-step check should be performed:

- Inspect helmet for obvious cracks, loose parts, or damaged cells or pads. Does it hold air?
- Check the crown by pulling down on the helmet to make sure it doesn't slide over the eyes.
- Grasp face mask and turn helmet side-to-side. Be sure skin wrinkles and that helmet doesn't just spin.
- Check that jaw pads touch cheeks and that ear holes align with ears.
- Check that the chinstrap is centered and snug, and the snaps hold well.

7. BEHAVIOR:

The mission of the Football Camp is to provide exceptional facilities, services, programs and experiences that engage, inspire and enrich lives. The following rules must be observed:

- Disruptive or dangerous behavior that jeopardizes the safety and well-being of others will not be allowed. Participants will be given a warning and will be dismissed from Football Camp if problems cannot be corrected.
- The use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, or any controlled substances by any participant will result in dismissal from Football Camp.
- Criminal behavior, including the unauthorized use of, theft of, or damage to the property of ISU, any other participant, or Football Camp Staff will result in dismissal from Football Camp.

Parents/guardians of dismissed participants will not be reimbursed the Football Camp tuition or fees.

I, as parent/guardian of the participating minor child, represent and warrant that 1) I have read the terms and agree to them, 2) I have the legal right to execute this document on behalf of the minor, 3) this document, once executed by me, is fully enforceable in accordance with its terms, and 4) I will indemnify the Released Parties in the event this representation is not accurate.
