**Chris Handy, MGCCC Men's Soccer**

Coach Handy is the Bulldog Men's head coach and oversees SMSC 01 and 03 Girls teams. Handy previously coached at Tyler JC where he was a part of two NJCAA National Championship teams. Handy played at Florida International where he started his coaching career.

**Nick Middleton, SMSC Director of Coaching**

Coach Middleton is the SMSC Director of Coaching. Collegiately, he played at Meridian Community College in 1999-2001 and was a member of the 2000 team that won the national championship. He later went on to play at Tennessee Wesleyan College from 2001 -2003 and was a member of the 2001 team that participated in the NAIA national tournament.
