Girls Soccer

GBS Girls Soccer is currently 13-3-5. They are coming off a tough 0-1 loss to Maine South to close out their CSL South schedule. Junior goalkeeper Libbie Vanderveen had five saves in the match. Even with the sad result, the girls still finished 2nd in the CSL South Division with a 3-2-0 record.

The team headed up to Madison, Wisconsin this weekend to take on Verona Area High School Friday night and Edgewood High School on Saturday.

The Titans defeated the Verona Wildcats, 3-0, with Sophomore forward Katie Weiss scoring 3:37 into the match from an assist by Sophomore forward Ellie Flowers. Junior midfielder Grace Evans added two assists with goals to Flowers in the 27th minute and Junior forward Izzy Archer in the 30th minute on a free kick off the crossbar. Sophomore goalkeeper Jessica Ehlinger had one save for her 2nd shutout of the season.

On an extremely hot Saturday tilt, the girls tied the Edgewood Crusaders, 1-1, with Katie Weiss scoring her 10th of the season on a penalty kick in the 65th minute to equalize a very hard fought game.

Final week of regular season play finishes with a trip to Milwaukee on Monday night versus 2017 state runner-up Wauwatosa East at 7:00PM. On Tuesday, the squad goes to Deerfield in a rematch of the semifinals of the Glenbrook Cup at 4:45PM.

Last two games will be at home with Maine West at 6:00PM and finally Teacher Appreciation/Senior Night on Thursday against the Crystal Lake Central Tigers at 7:00PM, both matches in the stadium.

1 Doubles-Christina Moy/Rhea Shah Second Place

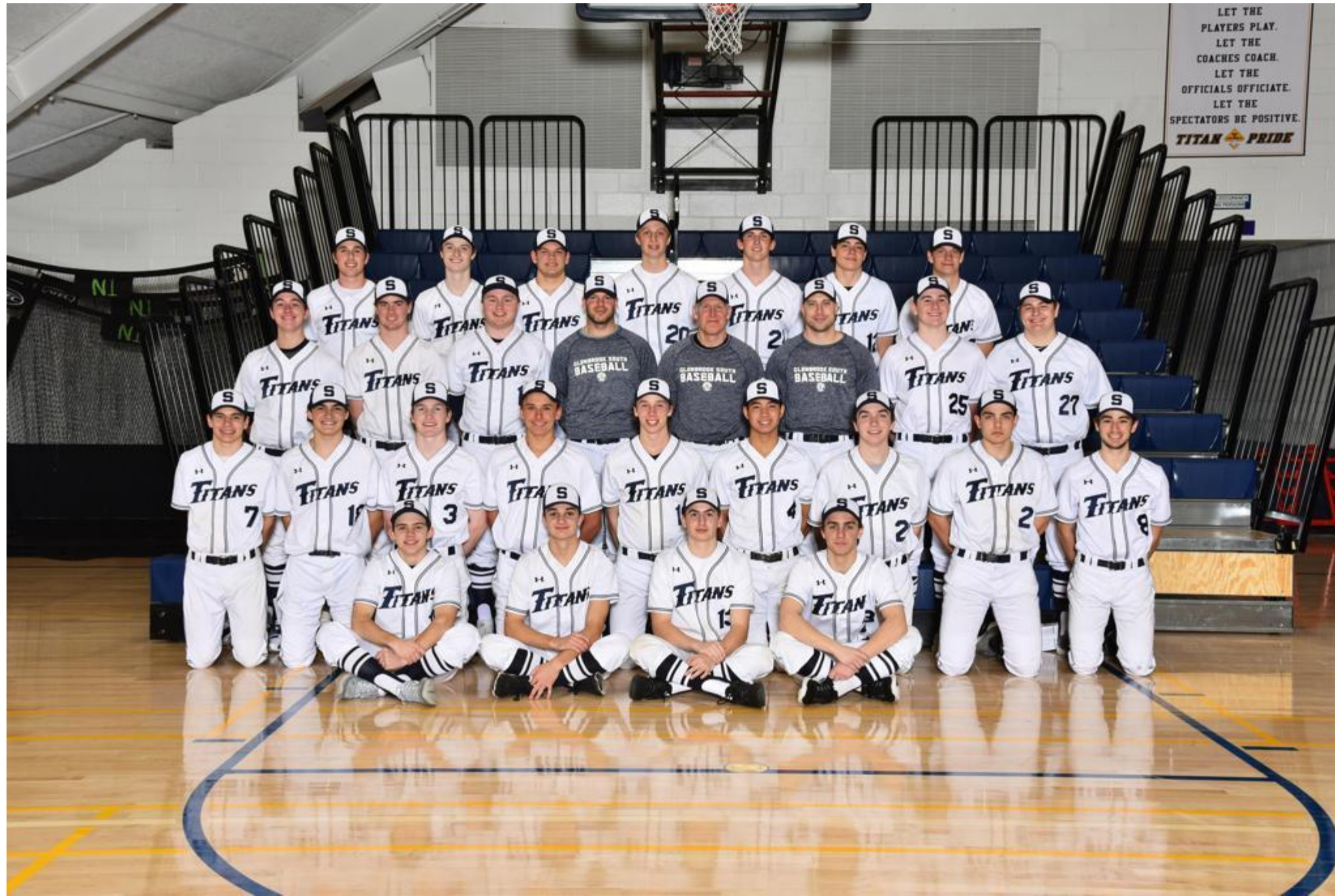
2 Doubles-Molly Sedin/Christina Joseph Third Place Players finishing 1-4 qualify for state.

The Titans Girls Track & Field team had a successful CSL South Outdoor Conference Championship Performance. The championship meet took place on Thursday, May 3rd at Maine South High School.

The Junior Varsity team finished in third place out of 6 competing teams.

Highlights included: First place finish by the 4x100 Relay team (MK Daley, Jaime Kim, Daphna Gerber, Renata Zalesky) and Andrea Llagas-Vergara in the 400m Dash. 2nd place winners were: Katherine Schurer in the 200m dash, 4x800m Relay (Madison West, Catherine Nowak, Emily Galante, and Bridget Wall), 4x200m Relay (Aaliyah Brown, Renata Zalesky, Dakota Betts, and Katherine Schurer), and the 4x400m Relay (Olivia Borth, Caelee Yum, Wallis Peterson, and Andrea Llagas-Vergara). Other great performances include MK Russell in Shot Put, Joanne Park in Pole Vault, MK Daley in Triple Jump, and Julia Kasner in Triple Jump.

The Titans Varsity finished in second place out of the 6 teams competing by a mere 20 points.

Highlights included: First place finish by the Sophomore Raelyn Roberson in the Long Jump. Her 18 feet 8-inch jump, broke a 14-year standing CSL Conference Record. Raelyn also finished as an individual conference champ in the 100m Dash and 200m Dash. Kate Jortberg finished as the conference champion in the 1600m run. The Titans 4x200m relay team also finished in First place (Maddy Batka, Kate Snively, Taylor Ozimek, and Raelyn Roberson). 2nd place winners were: Anne Streb in High Jump. Other great performances include: Kayleigh Pitterman in the 3200m run, Julie Villa in the 100m Dash, Emily Noone in the 800m run, Kathleen Bock in the 300m low hurdles, and Kate Snively in the 200m Dash. 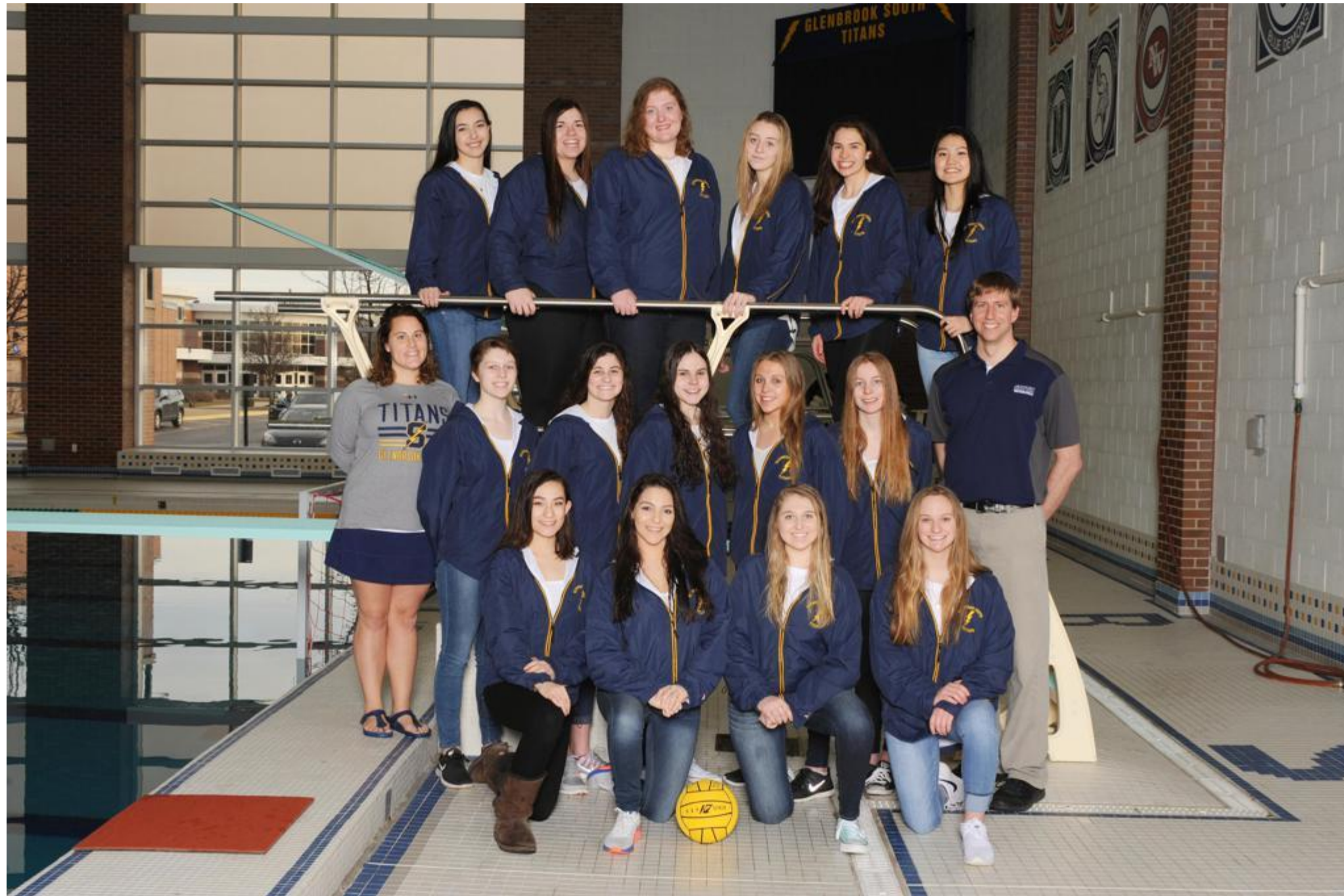
Boys Gymnastics

Boys Water Polo

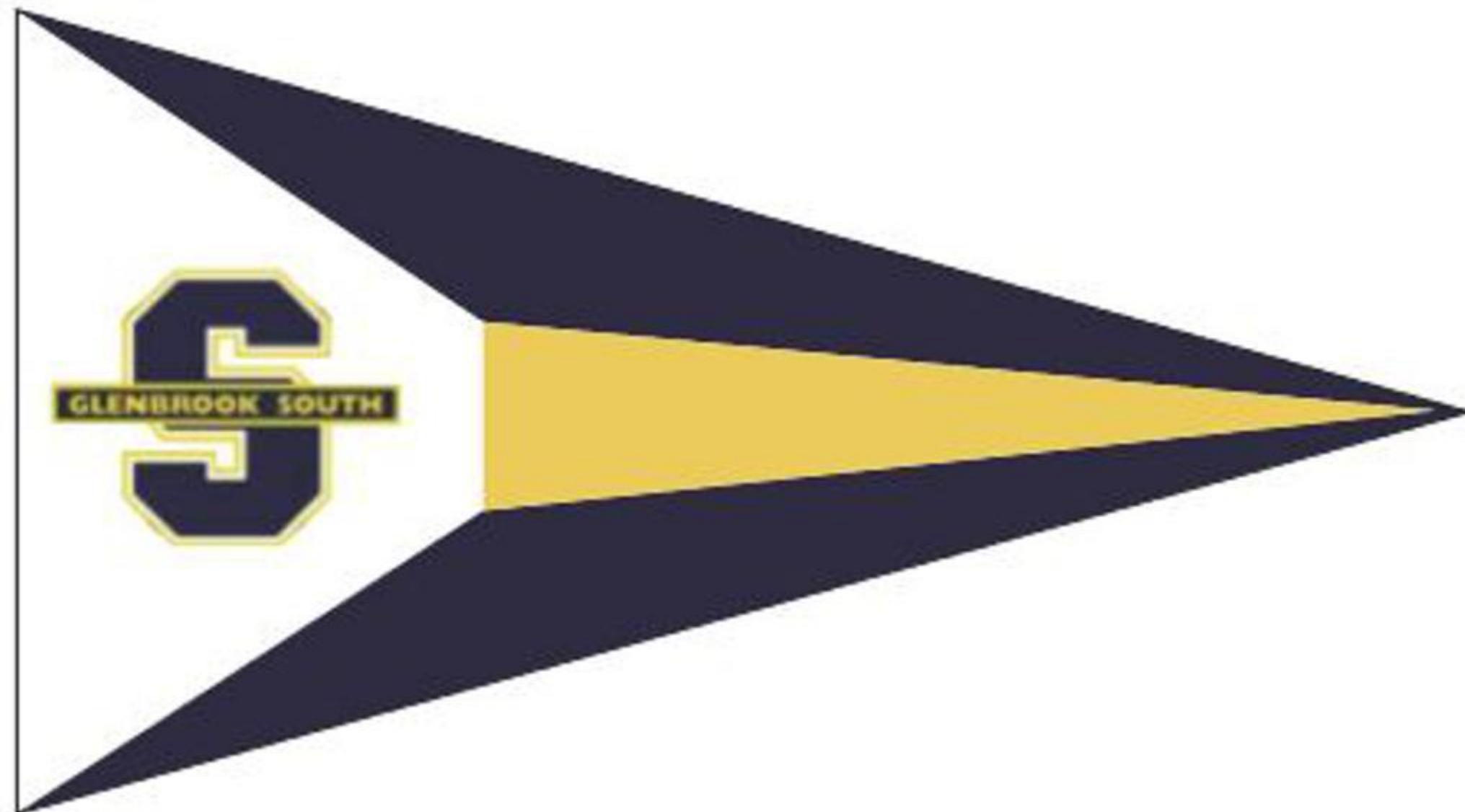
