1. Minutes

The minutes of the March meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

The fee for the track meet is \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student. If you have not already done so, please mail the track fee as well as any outstanding basketball or PLACT training fees to Mike Milligan.

All outstanding fees must be paid in full to enroll any teams in volleyball or soccer next year.

The treasurer’s report was approved. Thank you, Mike, for your excellent work as treasurer of the CGSAA.

3. Unfinished Business

The following volleyball rule change was approved:

. If the server elects to serve the ball in an overhand manner, a re-serve shall be called when the server releases the ball for service, then catches it or drops it to the floor. The referee shall cancel

the serve and direct a second and last attempt at serve. The server is allowed a new five seconds for the re-serve and must make contact with the second attempted toss. **A player may have only one re-serve during her term of service.**

4. Soccer

It was confirmed that according to the contract signed for the use of the Optimist Club's soccer fields, we will not have to pay any parking fees for the next two years. Keiffer continues to look for a better option for us after the next two years.

There are no rule changes for next year and fees should stay the same.

The number of soccer teams from each school will be due at the August meeting. Games will begin the weekend of September 8th. Keiffer will need the player and coach rosters by September 6.

5. Volleyball

We are no longer going to be playing in the Big Twelve. There is a possibility we can join the Suburban League. Beth will have more information at the May meeting.

The number of volleyball teams and gym availability will be due at the August meeting. Games will begin September 8th. Beth will need the player and coach rosters by September 6. The fee will remain the same next year at \$325 per team.

There will be a mandatory coaches meeting on August 8. Beth will go over rules and scoring.

6. Basketball
