



ALL-STAR MANAGER & COACH APPLICATION

In order to manage or coach an All-Star team, applicants must meet each of the following criteria:

1. 10/11/12 Baseball and Softball All-Star team managers and coaches must have been regular season team managers or coaches in the Major Division.
2. The 8/9/10 & 9/10/11 Baseball and 8/9/10 & 9/10/11 Softball All-Star team managers and coaches must have been regular season team managers or coaches in the AAA or Major Division.

All-Star managers and coaches must be approved by the PLL Board of Directors. There will be one manager and two coaches appointed by the board to each team. A committee made up of the President, Vice Presidents, and Player Agents will make recommendations to the board. The PLL Board will evaluate candidates based on responses provided below, the performance of the manager and team during the regular season and league playoffs, and the overall leadership characteristics exhibited by manager and coaching candidates before the final All-Star manager and coach selection is made.
