VOLUNTEER / FUNDRAISER REQUIREMENTS

CANDY BAR SALES

We will be participating in a candy bar sale, starting June 1st, 2018. **Four** boxes at \$60 per box are required per family for **full members**. You may choose to do the buyout of four boxes at \$30 per box or a combination of the two. For **Introductory** members, the requirement is **two** boxes/buyouts. All **full member** families are required to volunteer at the North St. Paul car show **two** Friday evenings during the summer to sell candy bars. For **Introductory** members, the requirement is **one** Friday evening. Please see the enclosed order form.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be required to sell a minimum of 4(2 if Intro) boxes or the equivalent buyout and to work at two (one if Intro) car shows to sell candy bars. This year there is an advance buyout option for the car show obligation by paying \$100 to the club by the membership renewal deadline, May 31. If this option is not exercised, & the required hours are not fulfilled, I will be invoiced \$150 per family for unfulfilled volunteer hours at the car show ____ (Initial here)

NORTH STAR SKATE SCHOOL HELPERS

We are requiring all MFSC skaters who are 12 years of age or older to help out with NSSS group lessons. Skaters will need to do 15 hours (8 hours for Introductory members) for the season between the months of June 2018 – May 2019. If your skater is under 12 years of age, the parent will need to do 8 hours (or 4 hours if Intro). This can be done by playing music at junior club or at skate school ice dance, working at skate school events or helping Nikki with paperwork. Each helper will need to attend a training session before they can begin.

Members who have not completed the balance of their required volunteer hours by May 31st 2019, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$150 per skater. The skater(s) shall be deemed “not in good standing” with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in synchro practice or competitions, skate in the MFSC Spring Show, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$150 per skater for unfulfilled shifts. ____ (Initial here)

RINK MONITORS

We are requiring all MFSC member families to help out by serving as rink monitors for contract ice sessions, similar to the skate school helpers. Families will need to do 15 hours for the season between the months of June 2018 – May 2019. Families who choose to do an “early” buy out on this requirement will pay at a rate of \$10/hour, or \$150 total. The early buy out is from June 1-Sept 1. After September 1, 2018 the buyout rate for rink monitor will be \$15 per hour or \$225.

VOLUNTEER / FUNDRAISER REQUIREMENTS, PG 2

Members who have not completed the balance of their required rink monitor hours by May 31st 2019, and have not chosen to do to the advance \$10/hour buyout, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$15/hour per skater, up to the maximum of \$225 if no hours were completed. The skater(s) shall be deemed “not in good standing” with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in competitions (synchro or individual), skate in the MFSC Spring Show, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid. Interested members may have the opportunity to work more than the minimum 15 hours to fill any “buy out” slots available and will receive a credit of \$7/hour for each hour worked over 15. Skaters over the age of 15 may also work as rink monitors.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$15 per hour for unfulfilled shifts. ____ (Initial here)

We choose the advance buyout for the rink monitor obligation and are enclosing a separate check for \$150. ____ (Initial here)

FALL CLASSIC COMPETITION

We are requiring a **minimum** volunteer effort of **2 shifts per family** (plus 1 additional shift for each additional skater) for **full members** at the Maplewood Fall Classic Competition, September 14th – 16th, 2018 at the Vadnais Heights Sports Complex. For **Introductory** members, the requirement is **1 shift per family** (plus 1 additional shift for each additional skater). This is a requirement for all members, **regardless if your skater is competing at the competition.**

Members who have not completed the balance of their required volunteer hours by September 16th, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$150 (plus an additional \$50 per additional skater). The skater(s) shall be deemed “not in good standing” with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in synchro practice or competitions, skate in the MFSC Spring Show, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$150 (plus \$50 for each additional skater) for unfulfilled shifts. ____ (Initial here)

MAPLEWOOD FIGURE SKATING CLUB “FALL SOCIAL CELEBRATION”

- Selling 8 tickets for the event (Introductory members sell 4 tickets)
- This year we are not requiring contributions of auction or raffle items
- Any member that has business connections or contacts that may be able to help get donated items for the auction and/or raffle, please let a board member know

VOLUNTEER / FUNDRAISER REQUIREMENTS, PG 3

Members who have not completed the balance of their required volunteer hours by the completion of the event, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$150 (plus an additional \$50 per additional skater). This fee DOES NOT include the cost of the required ticket sales. The skater(s) shall be deemed "not in good standing" with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in synchro competitions, skate in the MFSC Spring Show, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$150 (plus \$50 for each additional skater) for unfulfilled shifts. ____ (Initial here)

POLAR CONCESSIONS – PRE-SPRING SHOW

The club works the concession stand at Polar Arena in the weeks preceding the Spring Show. We are requiring each member family to commit to working 2 sessions in the stand. This is a requirement for all members, **regardless if your skater is participating in the show.**

Members who have not completed the balance of their required volunteer hours by the 2019 Spring Show, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$150. The skater(s) shall be deemed "not in good standing" with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in synchro practice or competitions, skate in the MFSC Spring Show, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$150 for unfulfilled shifts. ____ (Initial here)

BUTTERBRAIDS FUNDRAISER

We will be participating in a Butterbraids sale. It will be held in early spring 2019, prior to Easter. Each full member family will be required to sell 6 Butterbraids (Introductory 3). The buyout for members not participating is \$36 (Introductory \$18). There will be incentives and prizes for the top sellers!

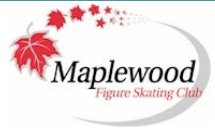

ASSOCIATE/ADULT/ALUMNI VOLUNTEER INCENTIVE

Associate members and Adult/Alumni members do not have volunteering requirements, but will be eligible for a volunteering incentive. If these members participate in any one of the fundraisers (such as, sell candy bars or work a shift at Fall Classic), they will be eligible for a partial membership refund of \$20.

The board of governors recognizes that the club has fundraisers and member requirements that possibly other clubs do not have. This is all in an effort to try to keep the ice costs per session as low as possible for all of our members. The board tries to keep the fundraiser/volunteer obligations to more of a “time” commitment than a monetary one (unless the member choses the buyout option).

We hope you understand our reasons for membership requirements.

CONTRACT / RANDOM ICE - SKATERS RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES

1. At the beginning of the freestyle session, the skater must check in with the Rink Supervisor stating your name and handing in your music. It is your responsibility to find the Rink Supervisor. If you cannot find the Rink Supervisor, please ask your pro or parent to check in the book to find out who is the Rink Supervisor for that session.
2. Generally, music will be played on a first come, first served basis. In the event that the session is full and many skaters wish to play their program music, skaters may only have one CD or track in line at a time, and may not play the same CD or track, or a different CD or track, until all other skaters' music in line has been played.
3. When it is your turn, please be prepared to skate your program. Music will only be stopped and restarted at the discretion of the Rink Supervisor.
 - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before their program music so other skaters are aware of who is skating their program.
 - b. When the skater performing their program is announced, the next skater to skate their program is also announced so the skater can put on a sash and be ready.
 - c. The skater is required to visibly wear the fluorescent colored sash while skating their program.
 - d. The skater wearing the sash has the right of way.
4. Random ice buyers must pay immediately upon entering the ice. Checks or punch cards only, no **cash or credit**. \$20.00 (or 4 punches) for a 1 hour Freestyle session, \$15.00 (or 3 punches) for a 45 minutes session, or \$27.00 for an Ice Dance session with a lesson (\$20.00 without a lesson). Skaters will be asked to leave the ice if they do not have payment.
5. If a skater's name isn't typed in on the attendance list, that skater may not go on the ice. The Rink Supervisor must write their name in the Random Ice Buyers Journal with a question mark and collect the appropriate fee for that session. These fees will be returned once the contract session is verified. The skater or parent must notify Joyce Schwartz at (612) 325-4665 for the claim.

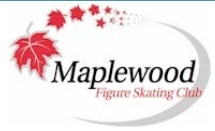

CONTRACT / RANDOM ICE - SAFETY CONTRACT

1. Respect the rights of other skaters.
2. No food, gum, or beverages (except plastic bottles of water) are allowed on the ice by skaters or coaches. No cell phones or personal music devices are allowed on the ice.
3. Skates must be worn on the ice – no street shoes or boots.
4. Skaters and/or Pros should not stand on the ice in the way of other skaters who are working. If you need to rest, go to the hockey box or off the ice. Do not sit on the boards or sit or lay on the ice. For short rests on the ice, stand with your back against the boards and away from the corners.
5. All skaters **MUST** be alert for fellow skaters on the ice to avoid collisions. Watch where you and others are going at all times. If a fall occurs, do your best to immediately get up and go to the side.
6. Watch for skaters executing jumps, spirals, camel spins, etc. Spins can only be practiced on the harness end of the rink between the blue line and the boards. Jumps should be executed from the same blue line to the other end of the rink. These rules do not apply when practicing your program.
7. When a skater is skating their program, the following rules apply:
 - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before playing their program music so other skaters and Pros are aware of which skater is skating their program.
 - b. The skater is required to wear the colored sash (clearly visible) while skating their program.
 - c. The skater with the sash has the right of way.
8. Skaters may use the jumping harness **ONLY** with the supervision of their Pro.
9. When the Rink Monitor announces the end of the session, skaters and Pros must clear the ice immediately.

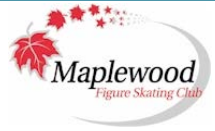
