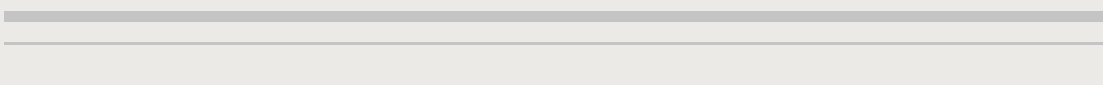

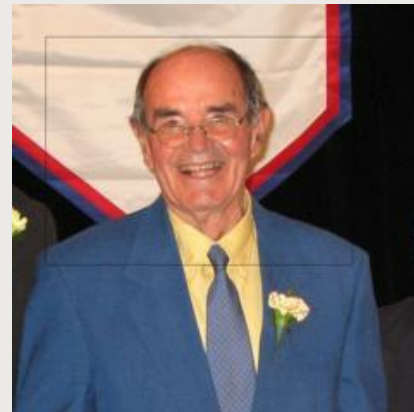

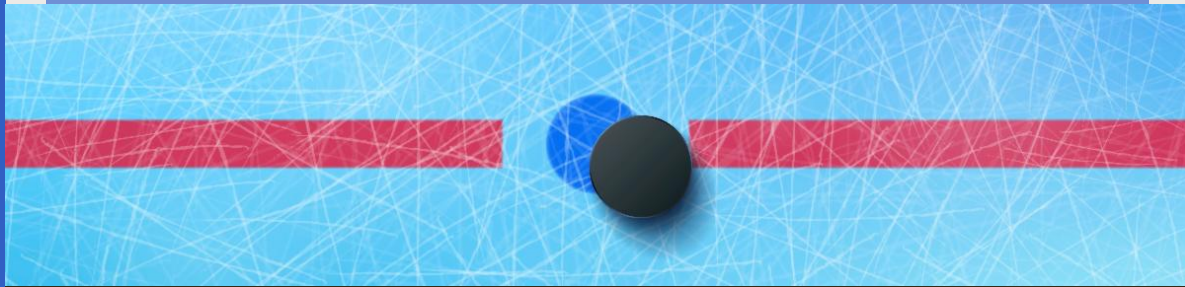
NYSAHA Inks Deal With GameSheet To Score Games
