 - Umpire fees projected to increase due to shortage.

- League bank account is stable - approximately \$40,000.
- Uniform costs are continuously increasing and will be evaluated for Spring Season.
 - Different styles?
- Proposed less total number of games for Spring Season to cut down on Umpire Fees.
- Approximately \$4,200 was profited during the Fall Season vs. the \$12,000 during Spring.
- \$7,300 net profit from the Fall Season Raffle Fundraiser – huge success.
