Introduction:

Assessors play an integral role in the development of Match Officials. They are the guardians of standards and provide a quality service towards promotion, development, and retention. The Assessor's role is to help Match Officials improve and contribute to their ongoing development.

Assessors have officiating experience and knowledge of the Laws of the Game. They must have the ability to view the game through the eyes of the Match Official while objectively analyzing their performance. It is imperative that Assessors can motivate officials while offering advice.

The Match Official Assessor program is part of Ontario Soccer's commitment to improving the standards of match officiating. Becoming an Assessor provides an opportunity for more experienced officials to give back to the game in a rewarding role.

Requirements to Apply:

- Currently registered Match Official in good standing with Ontario Soccer
- Minimum of 5 (five) years' experience as a District referee

Application Criteria:

There are several steps to take to become an Assessor with Ontario Soccer

- Submit an application with a resume (soccer-related) to Ontario Soccer for review
- Meet the requirements set by Ontario Soccer and Canada Soccer to be an Assessor
- Achieve 80% or better on a knowledge and understanding examination of the Laws of the Game
- Attend a two-day in-person Entry-Level Assessor course hosted by Ontario Soccer
- Attend the online NCCP Coach Evaluator course

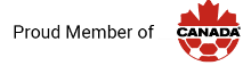
Your application will be reviewed by the Manager, Match Officials Development, and successful candidates will be invited to attend an upcoming Assessor Accreditation.
