

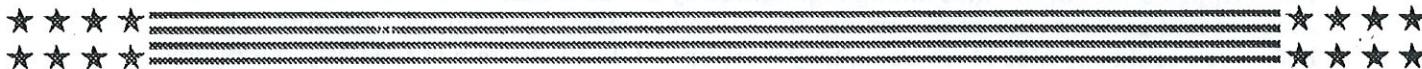

WORLD SERIES ENDS IN MOO MESA DEUX VICTORY!!

We would like to also thank all the players who participated in the league, and played within the spirit of good sportsmanship and friendship. We look forward to an even bigger and better league next year.

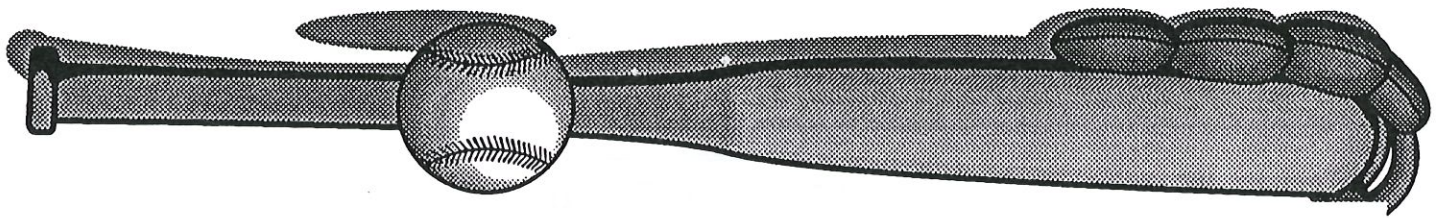
