# **Elite Basketball Organization Parent Contract 2019**

## **Team Practices:**

Players MUST be on time for practice. "On Time" means on the court, jewelry removed, wearing proper practice attire. (Shoes, practice jersey, adidas ONLY) Any player with 3 unexcused practices will be called before the Coach, Director and President.

## **Excused practices:**

1. Illness
2. Family Emergency
3. Any school sanctioned activity scheduled at the same time as EBO practice

If a player cannot attend practice, she is required to notify her coach as soon as she knows that she is unable to attend. Telling a friend does **NOT** qualify!!

## **Team Tournaments:**

1. Players must attend all scheduled tournaments.
2. Players are to be on their court, ready to warm up at the time assigned by their coach.
3. Athletes and/or parents are expected to provide transportation to and from tournaments unless it is an out of state tournament.
4. EBO will provide lodging or arrangements for their child at any overnight tournaments unless stated otherwise. EBO does not cover hotel costs for our White and Gold team.

## **Payments:**

We understand that the costs of operating a EBO team include, but are not limited to:

- Coaching salaries and travel expenses
- Club operational expenses
- Gym rental expenses
- Tournament expenses
- Other team expenses

**The Registration Fee must be paid up front and is not refundable.**

Due in hand on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (Payment schedule provided/ team). Payments can be mailed, delivered to EBO Administrative staff, via PayPal or in person Credit Card.

**Late Fee:**

- \$25.00 if payment is received between 5 to 10 days after the 1<sup>st</sup>
- \$50.00 if payment is received between 11 to 20 days after the 1<sup>st</sup>
- \$100.00 if payment is received between 21 to 31 days after the 1<sup>st</sup>
- If payment is more than 1 month behind, player will not be able to participate in any tournaments until balance is cleared.

**Financial hardship:**

In the event that a player requires financial aid, the EBO Officers will consider requests on a case-by-case basis. However, the financial aid exception aside, by accepting a place on a EBO team, Parent/Guardian and Player understand that they are committing to pay the full annual cost of the Travel Team. **If a player chooses to quit Elite Basketball Organization for ANY reason, they are still responsible to pay any remaining financial balance.** In the case of an injury while participating in EBO the financial responsibility will be discussed by Parent and EBO Officers.

**Parent/player expectations:**

All players and parents are expected to positively represent EBO by conducting themselves in an appropriate and respectful manner to all EBO coaches, players, parents, opposing team's, opposing coaches and officials.

EBO practices and tournaments are “open” for parents, friends, and relatives to watch. During these events players are expected to be 100 percent focused on their team. Parents are **NOT** permitted to “coach” from the sidelines.

No parent or family member may approach any EBO coach at any tournament, practice, by email or phone regarding any issue pertaining to coaching decisions, teams, or individual play. Players are encouraged to talk with their coach regarding any team concerns.

If there is a problem throughout the season dealing with inappropriate behavior or situations from players, coaches, parents, etc... please contact the club director/president.

**Playing time:**

EBO does NOT guarantee equal playing time on any team. Playing time is left to the discretion of the coach. EBO has the philosophy that payments are for instruction during practice. Coaches' decisions are non-negotiable. If a player has an unexcused absence during the season, her playing time may be significantly impacted at upcoming tournaments. All EBO decisions are final in regards to placements on particular teams or age groups.

**The 24 Hour Rule: Parent/Guardians agree to wait a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours after a game before requesting a meeting or discussion with the Coach.**

\*\*\*\*It is the parent and players responsibility to check the website often for important information!!!! This is the main source of communication and you will need to check it often!!!
