

FIELD USE EXPECTATIONS:

- If you cancel a game or practice please email me and let me know.
- If using Afton 6, Gladstone, Edgerton 6, 10 please complete the field work below.
- Don't forget to lock up the equipment box, field gates and make sure key is in the lockbox.

POST USE FIELD WORK:

1. Rake around home plate, and all bases (filling all low spots in the batter's box, and around the bases).
2. Rake base paths by pulling aggregate AWAY from the grass line.
3. Rake and reshape pitcher's mound. Push aggregate towards the mound, NOT the grass line.
4. Please grab a bucket of aglime from the pile and put back on the mound and rake/tamp the mound area as needed.
5. *If using Afton 6 see mound repair instructions below*
6. Clean-up dugouts after each use.

AFTON 6 MOUND/HOME PLATE AREA/BATTERS BOX:

1. Rake and reshape pitcher's mound. Push aggregate towards the mound and batters box area, not the grass line.
2. Please grab a bucket of aglime from the pile and put back on the mound and batter box area and rake/tamp the areas.
3. Use an old broom to sweep away the loose sand. It doesn't adhere well to ag lime.
4. Use a towel when you tamp it – otherwise it sticks to the tamp.
5. You need some water to make it pliable.
6. Top it with a clay / ag lime mix as it is slippery if it's just the clay that is exposed.
7. Cover mound and home plate area with tarp.

EQUIPMENT BOX AND FIELD LOCK UP:

- The key box is located on the fence by the equipment box.
- Code for the keybox is 24105.
- Please make sure to put the key back in the box and lock it immediately after opening what you need so it doesn't accidentally end up in someone's pocket at home.
- When leaving please ensure the field gates and the equipment box is locked.

In the equipment box is the following (if needed):

Two bags of chalk

Walk behind chalker

String line for snapping a line to follow for chalking

Tamper

Quick dry (*being delivered today or tomorrow*)

Flat shovel (*for scooping aglime*)

Bucket (*for transporting aglime*)
