Bracket Play: Gold & Silver – Best 2 out of 3; First two games to 25 (27 cap); Third game to 15 (17 cap) Awards:
 1st and 2nd place in Gold Bracket

Enter through main Elementary entrance – Door #2.

Coaches Check-In: See the check-in table near entrance to Gym 1. Check-in at least 15 minutes prior to your first match.

Warm-ups: 10 minutes (4:4:2) for the first match. 5 minutes (2:2:1) thereafter. First team listed has the court first, then switch. Both teams serve the third period. Please bring your own warm-up balls. Game balls will be provided.

Referees: Referees and scorekeepers will be provided. No line judges. Honor calls are expected.

Brackets: Placement determined on matches won. Tie-breakers: 1) head-to-head; 2) set won; 3) point differential; 4) coin toss.

Medical: Teams should have their own first-aid kits. Ice will be provided for any injuries.

Concessions: Full concessions are provided (fundraiser) and we would appreciate your support. Please keep all food in the cafeteria/commons area. No potlucks, coolers or team dinners allowed in the facility.
