Our Governor announced last night that we will have a 4-week pause during our hockey season effective Saturday morning. This is sad news for all of us. In order to complete our season and startup again December 18th we must follow his restrictions.

This means no hockey at any of our arenas. This also means no team practices in other states or college rinks. Many of you near the border will want to rent ice, I cannot stop a parent from renting ice out of state, but if I find out the team has practiced alone, or with parents or coaches, I will pull your roster for the remaining season. This also means no open hockey, 3X3, captains' practices, or anything else. I want our season to continue after the 18th.

We are also talking about extending the season into March and first part of April. More info on this will come out very soon. Parents are probably asking about refunds, let them know we are working on extending the season.

Please pass this on to all your members in the association, and stress that I will enforce the Governors orders.
