



PIUS XI CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL SOCCER SPECTATOR GUIDELINES - COVID-19

Due to Covid-19 restrictions and safety mitigation practices, Pius XI Catholic High School will follow varying guidelines as it pertains to spectators at all co-curricular events. Guidelines at each facility will differ based on varying factors, specific to each venue.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Masks are required to be worn by ALL spectators, coaches, players, and essential personnel at all Pius XI Catholic High School venues and athletic events. Spectators not wearing masks will be asked to leave.

General Guidelines:

- Stay home if exhibiting any symptoms of illness, especially new cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell, or a temperature of 100.3 or above.
- Practice social distancing
- Abide by posted signage and directions from event staff
- Masks are required both inside and outside
- Until further notice, there will be NO concessions sold at any of our contests.
- Events with multiple levels of play will be cleared out at the conclusion of each event.

Girls Soccer

- **VARSIITY** - Spectators will be limited to 3 spectators per participating student-athletes (home team and visiting team).
- **JV** - Spectators will be limited to 2 spectators per participating student-athletes (home team and visiting team).
 - Spectators will be allowed into the facility only if they are listed on a passlist.
 - Passlists must be submitted 24 hours prior to the event.
- Spectators must wear a mask at all times.
- Spectators may not congregate together, unless part of the same family or household.
- Spectators may only be within 6 feet of any player(s) if they are from the same household



Admission

- **Soccer:** No Admission
- Individual(s) that are on both the JV and the Varsity Pass List, will need to inform the Game Managers at the gate when you enter. JV players that have siblings on the Varsity team may stay, BUT must sit with their parents.

Limited Capacity

In order to maintain appropriate social distancing, spectator seating at the Uihlein Soccer Complex will be limited to 3 admissions per student athlete and essential game personnel for VARSITY GAME ONLY. JV will be allowed 2 admissions per student athlete. Spectators will be asked to clear the Uihlein Soccer Park after the JV games conclude.

Pass List

Each school will be allowed three on the passlist per player and coach on the gameday roster (household and/or family member) for the Varsity Game and two on the passlist for JV Games. Tickets are non-transferable once the passlist is submitted 24 hours in advance of the game. Each school will complete the gameday roster and spectator list and submit 24 hours prior to the game. Schools should submit their pass list to Kate Stone at kstone@piusxi.org. Spectators NOT on the pass list will be not allowed into the event.

Seating:

Avoid sitting directly in front or behind other spectators. Please allow a minimum of 6 feet between you or your family and others.

- JV Games - There are no bleachers or stands. We will be using the WYSA Club model where we ask spectators to sit on the same side as the players. We ask that visiting spectators on the pass list bring their own lawn chairs. Visitor Bench will be on the North East side with the Visiting Spectators on the South East side of the field. Pius XI Bench will be on the South Westside with the Pius XI spectators on the North West end of the field. Teams and Spectators should be diagonal from one another.
- Varsity Games - Will be played at Uihlein Park (Kohler Engine Stadium). Spectators on the pass list will be allowed in the Main Gate on the North End next to the main building (right off the parking lot). Only those on the pass list will be admitted. Visiting spectators will be on the South End of the bleachers and Pius XI spectators will be on the North End of the Bleachers.

Game Day Protocol

- No pregame or postgame handshakes
- Each participant will be required to wear a face covering except for when on the field during a match



- Coaches will wear face coverings at all times
- Each player not in the game will wear face covering
- Social distancing will be followed as much as possible on the sideline and bench areas. Each school should have their own water coolers. Each player should have their own water bottle
- A trainer might not be present for all home soccer matches due to multiple sports being played on the same day.
