



# 2026 Johnston Running Club Scholarship Application

The only requirement, aside from being a senior in high school that will be going to college this fall, is that recipients must have had some involvement with the Johnston Running Club, either as an athlete for the club or as a volunteer, or both. Even if you have not had involvement with the Johnston Running Club yet, there is still time for you to meet that requirement by participating as an athlete this spring or, perhaps more likely, volunteering with the club.

The steps in applying for the scholarship are:

1. Complete the application page (the second page of this document).
2. Type an essay no longer than one page on how running and/or track and field have impacted your life and how it will continue to be a part of your life in college and beyond (make sure your essay has your name on it).
