

How to Register

Novice, Atoms, Pee wee, Bantam, Midget Monday 10/12/2020

All players must be registered with USA Hockey before going on the ice or registering with Presque Isle Youth Hockey. Below you will find the web address to register with USA Hockey.

You will need a credit/debit card to complete this transaction. Cost is \$56.00. (Children 6 and under are free, but still need to register)

If you do not have a credit card or cannot register on-line, a payment method and computer will be made available to you on registration night Monday October 12th.

Once you have registered you will be able to print off a copy of your USA Hockey registration.

6:15-7:15 for Pee wee, Bantam, and Midget players

Helmets required for **ALL** players/coaches during free skate time.

Please bring all your **completed registration** materials with you to PIYH registration night. They include

- ✓ USA Hockey Registration
- ✓ PIYH Player Contact Information Sheet
- ✓ Player Contract (Code of Conduct)
- ✓ Parent Contract(**Signed by both parents/guardians if applicable**)
- ✓ Birth Certificate (We only need if your name is **not** on list attached)

This year's registration cost is \$350 per player (3rd/4th etc. child ½ price). This includes the \$50 raffle tickets you are able to keep or sell yourself. Cash or check will be accepted. If you bring everything completed, registration should go quickly so the kids can get on the ice. We would appreciate it if all players can make full payment at registration, if other arrangements need to be made we are requesting that you make a minimum \$100 initial payment per player.

We will no longer be accepting registration materials and checks at practices unless otherwise arranged. This practice has led to much confusion, lost paperwork and players on the ice not covered by insurance.

No player will be allowed on the ice until they have officially registered on-line through USA Hockey and provided the association with a copy of this confirmation.
