Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Statement

March 16, 2020

Dear West Yorba Linda Families,

It is with a heavy heart, again, that we update all of our families on the most recent information from Little League International. At 1:30 pm (PST) today, Little League International sent an email stating:

With the most recent guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Little League International Board of Directors and staff is now strongly advising all its local Little League programs to suspend/delay their Little League seasons through no earlier than Monday, May 11. We implore you to follow this recommendation and suspend all Little League activities through no earlier than May 11.

West Yorba Linda Little League will continue to follow the recommendations set forth by the Little League International Board of Directors and will suspend all league activities until May 11, 2020.

The West Yorba Linda Little League Board of Directors is also enlisting the advice and guidance of District 56 officials and Little League International, regarding such topics as resuming league play, as well as the financial implications associated with this suspension of Little League activities as we enter this unprecedented time. We realize that you have many questions, just as we ourselves do. The WYLLL Board of Directors will continue to meet and discuss the impact of this suspension and work to solve as much of this uncertainty as possible. Please be patient with us while we work to find solutions for questions that we know undoubtedly will arise.

Effective immediately:

1. NO voluntary or regular practices, including batting and bullpen work. Anyone caught violating this will be subject to disciplinary action.
2. NO team events (pizza parties, etc.).

There is no way of knowing what the next few weeks will bring. We can only hope that all this will turn out to be a bad dream and that we will resume playing baseball again in the very near future. Little League International is working on possible scenarios, such as shortening the season, eliminating District level tournaments, and other issues associated with this suspension.

Once again, we will distribute any and all information to you as soon as we get it.
