Required along with your show registration, please submit a **\$50 check** made out to St. Croix Valley Figure Skating. Checks will be returned to any applicant not selected. For all selected applicants, this check may be returned if parents **volunteers 6 hours** toward the show. Volunteer opportunities will be available for sign-up online at signupgenius.com.

Specialty Number Qualifications

1. Skate at dress rehearsal and ALL shows.
2. Meet soloist test level requirements by application deadline.
3. Costumes and music are the responsibility of the skater, subject to the approval of the Skating Director. Skaters are also responsible for scheduling, payment and everything related to the choreography of their program.
4. All specialty skaters must complete 7 out of the 14 skating/volunteer requirements below. They must be completed between January 24, 2025 to January 22, 2026.
 - Be contracted on 8 SCVRC Contract Sessions, since last year's show time (Spring 2025 – Winter 25-26) (Unlimited counts as 4 sessions)
 - Enrolled in 2 sessions of Learn2Skate/Competition Team/Production Number
 - Volunteer or teach a minimum of 9 hours for Learn-to-Skate
 - Registered in last year's show (Skating solely in the Varsity Number does not count.)
 - Participate in a SCVRC exhibition
 - Be a part of the Varsity Skating Program
 - Compete in an ISI competition and represent St. Croix Valley Recreation Center (must submit proof, Max of 2 requirements)
 - Compete in a USFS Competition (must submit proof, Max of 2 requirements)
 - Pass an ISI Freestyle Test (must submit proof)
 - Pass ISI Open Platinum at any time in the past.
 - Pass ISI Freestyle 9 or 10 any time in the past. May only use most recent test, not both. (must submit proof)
 - Pass an USFS Moves in the Field (must submit proof)
 - Pass an USFS Free Skate Test (must submit proof)
 - Pass a USFS Senior test any time in the past. (must submit proof)
(Each Senior test may count as completing 1 requirement. ie. Senior Moves & Senior Free = 2 requirements completed)

Senior Solo: The program length is limited to 2:00 minutes. To qualify, seniors must have been registered in the show as juniors, be contracted on at least 4 SCVRC Contract Sessions since the previous year's show. The skater must have passed one of the following; ISI Open Bronze Freestyle, ISI Freestyle 4, or USFS Bronze Skating Skills, along with the mandatory requirements above.

High Freestyle Solo: The program length is limited to 1:45 minutes. This skater must have passed one of the following tests; ISI Open Platinum Freestyle, ISI Freestyle 6, USFS Pre-Gold Skating Skills, or USFS Pre-Silver Singles.

Low Freestyle Solo: The program length is limited to 1:30 minutes. Skaters must have passed one of the following tests; ISI Freestyle 5, USFS Silver Skating Skills or USFS Bronze Singles.

Small Group: The program length is limited to 1:35 minutes. Skaters must have passed one of the following tests; ISI Open Silver Freestyle, ISI Freestyle 4, USFS Bronze Skating Skills or Preliminary Singles.

Step-Out Test Level Qualifications (2 skaters max) (:45 sec, music will be handed out): Skaters must have passed one of the following tests; ISI Freestyle 3 or ISI Open Bronze Freestyle. Must attend 2 out of 4 group practices.

All skaters who receive a specialty number in the show will receive FREE registration for the Opening Number.
