Student Attendance	Children have not been shown to be a high-risk group for serious illness from this virus. Standard educational services continue with all schools open. All existing policies for student attendance, excused absences remain in force. Refer to Parent/Student Handbook for attendance policies.	August 15, 2020	June 4, 2020	daily
Students with Pre-Existing Health Conditions	Students with pre-existing health conditions are at higher risk (i.e. medically fragile, asthma). School nurses will work with students and families on a case by case basis and as necessary to continue specialized health care plans and make appropriate accommodations to continue educational services	March 11, 2020	April 3, 2020	daily
Employee Attendance	All existing policies for employee attendance remain in force. Refer to collective bargaining agreements for attendance policies.	July 1, 2019	June 30,2020	not applicable
Meetings, Gatherings, and Events for Adults	Other than below, all meetings, gatherings and events where 50 or more adults would be in arm's length of one another are postponed or cancelled.
