Archer

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH APP & CASH ONLY.
 - Concessions will be accepting both CASH, CARD, CASH APP & Venmo.
 - Please advise your teams and coaches they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury only.
 - Water is provided at the concession stand.
 - For all games HOME Team will warm up at the far end of the field behind the scoreboard and AWAY teams will warm up in front of the concession stand to the left of the GFL tent behind the field goal.
 - Make sure to advise your coaches that they need to make sure they are cleaning up after themselves. There are trash cans all over the park. Please check the field before leaving to make sure you have all trash off the field.
 - NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - Tents can be set up on the grass areas to the left and right of the stands/bleachers.
 - NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS (including sports drinks, freeze pops, etc.) ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME. WATER ONLY.
 - The area immediately in front of the bleachers on both the home and visitors' side will be closed off. They will be clearly marked and taped off. Anyone in these areas will be asked to leave immediately.
 - ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS of any kind will be allowed entry. If you have a service animal, you must be able to provide documentation.
- AAA along with the GFL has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the rest of the year.

Berkmar

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH, CASH-APP & ZELLE
- Concessions will be accepting both CASH & CARD.
- Please advise your teams they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury.
- Football Teams - AWAY teams will warm up on the back football field closest to the scoreboard (Zone 6B). Cheer Teams - Away teams will warm up on the back football field closest to the bleachers on the AWAY SIDE (Zone 6A).
- Football Teams - HOME teams will warm up on the back end of the football field closet to the Press-box (Zone 1A). Cheer Teams- Home teams will warm up on the side of the football field closest to the Press- Box and Bleachers on the HOME SIDE (Zone1B).
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers... NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Tents can be set up on the Grass areas next to the bleachers.
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS (including sports drinks) ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT... NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME.
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, etc...
- ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS of any kind will be allowed entry. If you have a service animal, you must be able to provide documentation.
- BERKMAR has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry the rest of the year.
- No standing in front of Concessions unless you are making a purchase.
- No standing along the fence in ZONE 4
- Absolutely no practicing or playing in (Zone 3) grass area next to Concessions near the grills or fryer.
- Areas that have cones are for Berkmar Board Members and GFL REFS ONLY.



Brookwood

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH ONLY - Stamps will only be given out at the Front Gate
- Concessions accept CASH & CARD
- Please advise your teams they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc - unless needed for an injury
- HOME teams will warm up behind the Football Field scoreboard
- AWAY teams, with the exception of the first game of the day, will warm up to the left of the concession stand outside the fence.
 - A GFL Rep will give a reminder they have 15 before game time as a courtesy
 - First game of the day will warm up in the endzone area close to our CONCESSIONS
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - Tents can be set up on the grass areas to the left and right of the stands/bleachers
 - The ONLY tent allowed on the field is the GFL TENT
 - Teams CANNOT set up their tent on the field
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME
- CHEER AND FOOTBALL TEAMS CANNOT THROW CANDY IN THE STANDS – HOME NOR AWAY TEAMS
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- After the game:
 - Coaches should take their teams off the turf field immediately
 - Home Team should use the grassy area at the end of the home-side bleachers
 - Away Team should use the grassy area at the end of the away- side bleachers.
- Brookwood Football Association has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE RULE...AGGRESSIVE / DISORDERLY BEHAVIOR = PARK EJECTION & POSSIBLE BAN!

BUFORD

- Gate Admission - CASH ONLY
- Concession Stand - CASH ONLY
- Ice - NO ice will be provided for team coolers or water bottles. Ice will be for injuries only.
- Water for team coolers will be provided via the water hose located immediately outside the sports complex meeting room.
- NO pop-up tents/canopies are allowed in the bleachers/stands or on the field.
- These are allowed on the concrete areas to the left and right of the bleachers.
- The only tent allowed on the field is the Buford GFL tent.
- Teams will warm-up on "Field B." This is the first field up the steps.
- HOME team will warm up towards the far end. (Same end the scoreboard is located.)
- First game of the day will warm up in the end zone near the scoreboard.
- AWAY team will warm up on the end closest to the parking lot/front gate.
- First game of the day will warm up in the end zone near the concession stand on the game field.
- Please advise your team to clean up their sideline after the game is over.
- No filming is allowed from inside the press box. All filming must be on top of the pressbox roof or from your respective bleachers/stands.

If anyone needs assistance, please look for one of our GFL reps under our tent. We will be happy to assist.

Collins Hill

- Entry Gate Admission is Card or Tap Only (No Exceptions)
- Concessions will accept both cash and card payments.
- Water is provided via a water hose located under the press box. All teams will need to supply their own ice. We do not provide ice or water bottles.
- For the first game of the day, both teams will utilize the playing field to warm up.
- For the remainder of the day, the home team will warm up behind the active score board (to the left closest to the press box) and the visiting team will warm up behind the non-active score board (to the right, farthest from the press box).
- No one is allowed in the Press box except Quik Cuts, the home team announcer, Cheer assistants (for half time music) and the time clock official.
- No canopies or pop-up-tents in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS! Tents can be set up on the grassy areas to the side of the stands/bleachers.
- The area immediately in front of the bleachers on both the home and visitors' side will be closed off to the public. They will be clearly marked and chained off. ANYONE IN THESE AREAS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS (including sports drinks) ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME.
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, etc...
- ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS of any kind will be allowed entry. You must provide documentation for your service animal.
- CHYAA, along with the GFL has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the rest of the year.

DACULA

- Entry Gate Admission AND Concession is CASH, CARD (\$.50 FEE), TAP (\$.50 FEE), AND CASH APP (\$1 PER \$25 FEE)
- Ice is not available from our concessions unless needed for an injury
- Both teams, except for the first game of the day, will warm up on the field located behind the press box. A rep will notify coaches when there are 5 minutes left in the 4 th qtr. of the game and are expected to be in the back of the endzone waiting for the game to finish with 2 mins. remaining in the 4 th qtr.
 - Allow the teams finishing the game to clear the bench before placing things on the bench
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, bandaids, knee pads, etc...
- The ONLY tent allowed on the field is the GFL TENT...THAT IS IT
 - Teams CANNOT set up their tent on the field
- **THERE IS A ZERO TOLERANCE RULE...AGGRESSIVE / DISORDERLY BEHAVIOR = PARK EJECTION & POSSIBLE BAN!**

Duluth

- *Gate Admission – CASH & CARD
- *Concession Stand - CASH & CARD
- * Ice - NO ice will be provided for team coolers or water bottles. Ice will be for injuries only.
- *Water will be provided at the concession stand.
- * Team Warm up area
 - Home team will warm up in the end zone by the scoreboard
 - Away team will warm up in the end zone by the concession stand.
- * Please advise your team to clean up their sideline after the game is over.
- * ONLY referees, announcers, Cheer assistant and Qwik Cuts are allowed in the press box.
- * NO parking on the grass or at the maintenance building. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

Gainesville

- Gate Entry and Concessions: NO CASH. Either Cash App, tap to pay, or Venmo.
 - Teams are not able to get ice or water bottles from concessions
 - The teams playing the first game of the day will warm up on the game field. The video board side is the home warm up side.
 - Upon arrival, teams will go directly to respective warm up areas.
 - Fifteen minutes before the game, teams will be given a 5 minute warning.
 - At ten minutes before the game, the teams will be escorted to their assigned sidelines.
 - Head coaches must be mindful of the time.
 - Immediately after the game, teams must vacate the stadium and gather in the visitor parking lot to ensure a smooth transition for the next game.
 - Fans should enter and exit through the visitor side gate.
 - No pop up tents allowed inside of the stadium.
 - Only water allowed on the sidelines. Coaches/players shouldn't leave anything behind KEEP OUR FIELD CLEAN
 - ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS of any kind will be allowed entry. You must provide documentation for your service animal.
 - ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the rest of the year.
- The ONLY tent allowed on the field is the GFL TENT



Grayson

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH ONLY - WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANYTHING ELSE OTHER THEN CASH...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Concessions will be accepting CASH & CARD
- Please advise your teams they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury- HOME teams will warm up behind the Football Field scoreboard
- **PARK IN A DESIGNATED PARKING SPOT - DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS OR YOU WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE**
- AWAY teams, with the exception of the first game of the day, will warm up on Baseball Field 1 which is located diagonally from the main entrance
 - This is nothing new, we have been doing this for MANY SEASONS, so please advise your coaches NOT to give any lip about it...There is always one that says something
 - A GFL Rep will walk to the Baseball Field to give a reminder they have 15 before gametime as a courtesy
 - First game of the day will warm in the endzone area close to our CONCESSIONS
- Visitors that attend the last game of the night will need to exit out the gates behind the visitors' bleachers.
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - Tents can be set up on the concrete or grass areas to the left and right of the stands/bleachers
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME
- CHEER AND FOOTBALL TEAMS CANNOT THROW CANDY IN THE STANDS – HOME NOR AWAY TEAMS
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- The ONLY tent allowed on the field is the GFL TENT...THAT IS IT
 - Teams CANNOT set up their tents on the field
- Grayson A.A. has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE RULE...AGGRESSIVE AND DISORDERLY BEHAVIOR = PARK EJECTION & POSSIBLE BAN!

Lanier

- Gate: Cash or Cash App
- Concessions: Cash, Card or Cash App
- Press Box: ONLY referees, Announcer, Cheer assistants and QWIK Cuts allowed inside. Coned Parking: Reserved parking for GFL Representatives and Referees.
- NO ICE WILL BE GIVEN OUT, ONLY WATER
- Pop-up Tents: No Pop-Up Tents allowed in the stands/bleachers.
- ONLY tent allowed on field is the GFL tent.
- ONLY WATER ALLOWED ON FIELD/TURF – NO FRUIT OR SUGARY DRINKS
- Pop-Up Tents may be placed to the right and left side of the bleacher in the grassy area behind the fence.
- AT NO TIME MAY CANDY OR FOOD BE THROWN IN STANDS
- TEAMS / SQUADS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR GAME IS OVER
- NO ANIMALS AT THE PARK
- ZERO TOLERANCE FOR UNRULY BEHAVIOR

Lawrenceville

- Entry Gate Admission AND CONCESSIONS are CASH, CARD, APPLE PAY or CASH APP- Stamps will only be given out at the Front Gate
- Please advise your teams they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions but water is available
- HOME teams will warm up in the grass outside the main entrance
- Visitors will warm up behind the Visitors stands.
- First game of the day will warm up on the main field
- A GFL Rep will give a reminder that they have 10-15 before game time as a courtesy
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Tents can be set up on the grass areas to the left and right of the stands/bleachers
- Teams CANNOT set up their tents on the field
- We do allow 1 coach from each team in the press box.
- NO DOGS in the main gate.
- NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- Coaches should take their teams off the turf field immediately
- LYAA has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE RULE...AGGRESSIVE / DISORDERLY BEHAVIOR = PARK EJECTION & POSSIBLE BAN

Millcreek

- Entry Gate Admission is cash only, stamps are only given at the front gate
- Concessions accept cash, credit card & Apple Pay
- Advise your teams they will not be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury
- Please note: the home side are the bleachers at the press box, and the Away side are the bleachers on the side of the scoreboard.
- No one is allowed in the Press box except Quik Cuts, the home team announcer, Cheer assistants (for half time music) and the time clock official.
- Warm-ups:
 - Home teams will warm up on the far side of the field closest to the press box
 - Away teams will warm up on the far side of the field closest to the scoreboard.
 - For the first game of the day, teams will warm up on the turf field
 - Everyone will enter through the main gate to pay or get your cards punched
- After the game:
 - Coaches will gather their teams in the corners of the field closest to the concession stands.
 - Home teams should meet by the entry gate side
 - Away teams should meet at the far side of the concession stand
 - Fans and players will exit the front the same way they came in.
- No popup tents are allowed in the stands/bleachers but can be used in the grass area on either side of the bleachers.
- Only water is allowed on the fields and there should be no food on the turf
- Please advise your teams to clean up their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- We will have spaces marked by cones for Referees and GFL Board. Please tell your parents not to move the cones or drive over them.
- If any coach/director has an issue while at Duncan Creek Park for their game, they can contact Ishmael Johnson at 702-348-9348, text preferred
- MCAA, along with the GFL has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the rest of the year.

Mountain View

Entry & Concessions

- Gate admission: Cash, Card, and Tap accepted
- Concessions: Cash & Card accepted
- Ice will NOT be provided from concessions for coolers/water bottles (ice is only available if needed for an injury).
- Water is available near the concession stand.

Parking

- DO NOT park in the front row next to the entrance gate.
This area will be blocked off on game days for working staff only.

Field & Sideline Guidelines

- All teams (Home & Away) will warm up at the far end of the field near the scoreboard.
 - Away team → Left side of scoreboard
 - Home team → Right side (near press box)
- Coaches and teams must clean up after themselves. Trash cans are available throughout the field — please check and clear your sidelines before leaving.
- No pop-up tents are allowed in the stands/bleachers (no exceptions). Tents may be set up on the grass areas to the left or right of the bleachers.
- No fruit or sugar drinks (including sports drinks) are allowed on the field at any time — not even at halftime.

Sportsmanship & Safety

**MVAA and GFL will continue to enforce a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for misconduct, aggression, or violence towards players, coaches, referees, GFL reps, or parents. Offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the remainder of the year.

Norcross



- Admission is CASH ONLY (No bills over \$20 preferred) - WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANYTHING OTHER THAN CASH...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Concessions are Cash or Card.
- The first game of the day: Players, coaches, and team moms will be allowed to enter at 8am. Spectators can enter at 8:30am.
- Parking is on Mitchell Street (484 Mitchell Rd NW, Norcross, GA 30071) in the parking lot across from the Cemetery Field sign. There is a photo attached to assist with directions.
- ONLY officials, police, GFL board members, and Home Team Coaches/Team Moms are allowed to park in the parking lot on S. Cemetery Street. You must show your badge for entry. Please relay to your teams and parents, they will not be able to turn around in the parking lot to drop off athletes.
- COACHES MUST BRING THEIR OWN ICE. Teams will only be able to get ice from our concession stand if an injury occurs.
- Water is provided via a water hose located on the side of the field house.
- HOME teams will warm up behind the goal post on the left side of the field (Cemetery side).
- AWAY teams will warm up on the grass outside of the entry gate, behind the scoreboard.
- The first game of the day, both teams will warm up on the turf.
- Coaches- Do not walk on the field when a game is in progress. You will need to use the bleachers to get to the other side of the field.
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers. Tents can be set up on the grassy area near the sidewalk that leads to the bleachers/stands. (DO NOT BLOCK THE SIDEWALK)
- The restroom is on the left side of the concession stand. ONLY ATHLETES and COACHES have access to restrooms on the side of the field house.
- WATER ONLY ON THE FIELD! NO SUGARY DRINKS (GATORADE, POWERADE, etc.)
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, etc...
- NO ANIMALS allowed! If you have a service animal, you must be able to provide documentation.
- Coaches should take their teams back to the warm up area immediately after their game is over.
- Home Team Fans Fans need to be patient when leaving the bleachers and will exit out the side gate if they are leaving the Away side and should exit the front gate if they are leaving the Home side
- Norcross has zero tolerance for coaches, team moms, and spectators who violate the NYAA and GFL code of conduct. If you are in violation, you will be asked to leave or you will be removed by the Gwinnett County Police Department.

North Gwinnett

- *Entry Gate Admission is cash only, stamps are only given at the front gate
- *Everyone who comes to the game should get a stamp as our restrooms and concession stand are outside of the fence
- *Concessions accept cash, credit card & Apple Pay
- *Advise your teams they will not be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury
- *Please note: the home side is the bleachers with the shades, and the Away side is the bleachers near the press box
- *Warm-ups: (First game of the day warms up on turf field)
 - Home teams will warm up on Softball Field #6
 - Away teams will warm up on Softball Field #7
- *A GFL Rep will walk to the softball fields to come and get teams when we are ready for them to come down to the turf field. We won't give a 15 minute warning so pay attention to the prior game and be ready to follow the GFL rep down when they come to get you. DO NOT come down to the stairs until a GFL Rep comes to get you or you will be sent back to the warmup fields.
- *Coaches and Team moms will only be able to get in free to the game that they are coaching and will need to walk with the team down the stairs by the side gate to get their lanyards punched. If they come to the main gate, they will be charged. Coaches and team moms can ask for a stamp on the way out through the main gate after their games
- *After the game:
 - Coaches should take their teams off the turf field immediately and meet outside the gates
 - Home teams should meet by the lacrosse wall
 - Away teams should meet by the concession stand near the batting cages by Softball Field #7
 - Fans need to be patient when leaving the bleachers and will exit out the side gate if they are leaving the Away side and should exit the front gate if they are leaving the home side
- *No popup tents are allowed in the stands/bleachers
- *Only water is allowed on the fields and there should be no food on the turf, especially any nuts as we have children with severe peanut allergies in our association
- *Please advise your teams to clean up their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- *Parents/guardians/coaches should not drop off children at the curb; this is dangerous and will be blocked off by traffic cones. Make sure to advise everyone not to drive over the cones or move them
- *If any coach/director has an issue while at George Pierce for their game, they can contact Brittany Robinson 954-559-2671, text preferred

Parkview

- * Entry Gate Admission is CASH ONLY - WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANYTHING OTHER THEN CASH...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- * Concessions will be accepting both CASH & CARD.
- * Please advise your teams they will NOT be able to get ice from our concessions for coolers, water bottles, etc... unless needed for an injury.
- * Water is provided via a water hose located by the concession stand.
- * For games before noon - HOME & AWAY teams will warm up on Baseball Field 5 which is located directly diagonally from the main entrance.
- * For games after noon - HOME teams will warm up on Baseball Field 6 which is the field located behind the press box. AWAY teams will warm up on Baseball Field 5 which is located diagonally from the main entrance.
- * It is best for the coach first arriving for warm-ups to visit our gate & we will direct them to the correct field.
- * A GFL Rep will alert the team as it gets closer to their game time so they can make the walk to the field.
- * The first game of the day will warm up on the main field.
- * NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- * Tents can be set up on the concrete areas to the left and right of the stands/bleachers.
- * The area immediately in front of the bleachers on both the home and visitors' side will be closed off to the public. They will be clearly marked and chained off. Anyone in these areas will be asked to leave immediately.
- * NO FRUIT OR SUGAR DRINKS (including sports drinks) ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME.
- * Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, etc...
- *ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS of any kind will be allowed entry. If you have a service animal, you must be able to provide documentation of that.

PEACHTREE RIDGE

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH & CARD.
- Concessions will be accepting both CASH & CARD.
 - If you have a child that plays at a later game. Please have them wear this season's jersey or Cheer uniform, Otherwise, they will be charged entry.
- Please advise your teams and coaches that we will provide water for their water jugs. Water is available at the concession stand. Please come to the concession stand window to ask. Do not just walk into the concession stand. Ice will be available for 7.00 a bag.
- We have a small turf warm up area on each side of the field once you step on to the field at the far end.
- Make sure to advise your coaches that IT IS NOT OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CLEAN UP BEHIND THEM. There will be a trash cans around the park for them to put their trash in.
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- NO Standing along the fence in front of the stands. If you like to stand along the fence, please do so in the grassy areas.
- Tents can be set up in the grass on either side of the stands but not on the concrete areas.
- NO FOOD, FRUIT, OR SUGARY DRINKS (including sports drinks) ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD AT ANY POINT...NOT EVEN DURING HALFTIME. WATER ONLY on the field. (This includes gum)
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their trash after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, pompom lint, hair ties ECT...
- NO PETS INSIDE GATES.
- PLEASE ADVISE YOUR PARENTS NOT TO DROP THEIR CHILDREN OFF AND LEAVE.
- Peachtree Ridge along with the GFL has and will continue to enforce the ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for any misconduct, aggression and/or violence towards players, coaches, referee's, GFL Reps, other parents, etc. All offenders will be escorted off the premises and banned from re-entry for the rest of the year.

- Entry Gate Admission is CASH and CASHAPP-
- Concessions will be accepting CASH and CARD
- No Ice will be provided at the concession stand unless for injury. There is water at the practice field entrance if needed.
- Home and away teams warm up on the practice field noted on the attached photo
 - *A GFL Rep will walk to the practice field to give a reminder they have 15 before gametime as a courtesy
- NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Only water on the field (no sports drinks etc.)
- Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their mess after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, band aids, knee pads, etc...
- Only Tents allowed will be on the track for GFL and paramedic
 - *No tents on field whatsoever
- No coaches are allowed in the press box. ONLY referees, announcers, Cheer assistant and QwikCuts are allowed in the press box.
- The area immediately in front of the bleachers on both the home and visitors' side will be closed off to the public. They will be clearly marked and chained off. ANYONE IN THESE AREAS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.

Parking

*We have open parking at South. Referees should park in the front row in the parking lot right in front of the football field; there will be orange cones to designate the area. Please relay to your parents, they will not be able to park right in front of the gates for drop offs. They will need to park and walk their children to the entrance.

Ice & Water

*South will provide FREE ice to all teams. Ice will be provided at the concessions stand. There is a waterspout on both sides of the field. (It's on the field).

Warm-Ups

*The first game of the day: Players, coaches, and team moms will be allowed to enter at 8am.

Spectators can enter at 8:30am.

*The first game of the day, both teams will warm up on the turf.

*Both Home & Away Teams will warm up on the baseball fields which are located on the other side of the football field. Do not cross the football fields to enter the baseball fields. GO AROUND!

Bleachers / Stands

*South's Bleachers are all on one side. There will be designated areas for home & away team spectators

*NO POP-UP TENTS in the stands/bleachers. Tents can be set up on the right side of the stands/field.

*The restroom is on the back side of the concession stand.

Football Field

*WATER ONLY ON THE FIELD! NO SUGARY DRINKS (GATORADE, POWERADE, etc.).

* No food /snacks of any kind on the field.

*ABSOLUTELY, No tents on the field.

*Please advise your teams to CLEAN UP their "mess" after their game is over - Water bottles, mouthpieces, tape, paper, Band-Aids, knee pads, etc...

Press Box

*Remind your announcers that the GFL statement MUST be read before each game. We will have a copy of the statement in the press box. Please keep it clean and tidy.

MISC

*NO ANIMALS allowed! If you have a service animal, you must be able to provide documentation.

*South Gwinnett has zero tolerance for coaches, team moms, and spectators who violate the SGAA and GFL code of conduct. If you are in violation, you will be asked to leave or you will be removed by the Gwinnett County Police Department.
